In conjunction with the Director of Facilities, Tim Ames, it is recommended that the Board of Education award the contract in the aforementioned category to the low bidders meeting specifications: Covanta, for an estimated value of \$22,500.00 and Allied Waste for an estimated value of \$4,250.00.

The bid was split by classification of what is commonly considered combustible refuse or "burnables" and then "bulk" (furniture, refrigerators, stoves, etc.). Covanta will incinerate most of our refuse at their facility; Allied only handles "bulk" at their landfill in Niagara Falls.

The term of the contract will be for one year with the option of renewing for up to three years provided that the Board of Education continues the appropriation in successive years and also that the agreement is mutually satisfactory to both parties. The contract date for renewal will occur in October of each year and will be tied to the floating date scheduled for meetings by the Board of Education.
