Dear Parents, Guardians and Students,

We are pleased to announce that this year we will be starting an event that could become a new and special tradition at Kenmore West. All June 2018 graduates will participate in a Senior Walk that will take place on Friday June 8, 2018.

The purpose of the Senior Walk is a celebration and recognition of our 2018 graduates. All June 2018 graduates will participate in a field trip back to their Ken-Ton elementary school. Students who attended schools that are no longer open will be allowed to select another Ken-Ton elementary school to visit.

The following details explain the logistics of the Senior Walk event:

- o All students who are on track to graduate in June 2018 will be permitted to participate in the June 8th Senior Walk
- o Participants will need to have parents sign a field trip permission slip that includes their home elementary school or elementary school of their choosing (due in Main Office by May 24th)
- o Senior Walk participants will need to wear their commencement cap and gown (cap and gown is required and decorating of caps is NOT permitted for Senior Walk or Commencement)
- o On June 8th, Senior Walk participants will report to the Starr Auditorium at 8:30 AM with caps and gowns
- o Students will be seated alphabetically in sections of the auditorium according to their home elementary school
- o Students will participate in a Senior Walk rehearsal
- o Students will be called to board their respective busses
- o Students will be bussed to their respective Ken-Ton elementary schools
- o Students will be assembled in the elementary school auditorium and lined up for the procession
- Current elementary school students and staff will be lined up in the hallways outside of their classrooms
- o An announcement will be made on the public address system, signaling the start of the walk
- o June 2018 graduates will walk through the hallways in an orderly manner
- o Graduates will complete the processional by boarding their respective busses



Please find below a summary of information for our 2018 Senior Walk:

o CAP & GOWN

Seniors should have already ordered his/her cap & gown. If you have not done so, please call Jostens at 688-4077 ASAP. Ask for Mr. Tom McGrath. Please note that the wearing of a cap and gown is required and decorating of caps is NOT permitted.

o SENIOR WALK REHEARSAL

Rehearsal is mandatory and will take place on June 8th at 8:30 AM

SENIOR WALK ATTENDANCE

Attendance is optional; however, graduates are encouraged to participate in this special experience. Students who do not participate will remain in their assigned classes.

SENIOR WALK EXPECTATIONS

We want to ensure that this event is a positive, respectful, and dignified event for all students.

o REQUIRED DRESS FOR SENIOR WALK

A blue cap and gown is required dress for the ceremony and must be worn by every graduate Decorating of caps is NOT permitted

Men: suit or shirt, tie, slacks/dress pants, & dress shoes

Women: dress, dress pants, or skirt & blouse

NO jeans, shorts, sneakers, work boots, or flip flops

No gum chewing
