




• Partial/Whole Roof Replacement (Holmes, Franklin Middle, Hoover Middle, Kenmore East, Kenmore West): The project will include the replacement of the entirety of the Holmes Elementary roof, and partial roof replacement at the middle/high schools.

• Other (All Schools): Other critical capital work is planned such as parking lot/sidewalk resurfacing at all schools, new carbon monoxide detectors at all schools, window replacement and classroom/office renovations at Edison and Lindbergh Elementary, and unisex single-occupant restrooms at middle/ high schools.

VOTER QUALIFICATIONS:

- Registered to vote by five days prior to Feb. 5, 2020
- U.S. citizen, 18 years of age or older
- Resident of the district for 30 days prior to the vote
- Proof of citizenship, age, and residency required
- You do not have to register if you are already registered with the Erie County Board of Elections or have voted within the past four years.

ABSENTEE BALLOT INFORMATION:

- Those who already receive absentee ballots do not need
- Applications must be received no later than seven days prior to Feb. 5, 2020. Absentee ballots must arrive no later than 5 p.m. on Feb. 5, 2020.
