# 2. What does A therapy dog do at school?

The dog has many different jobs at school. The therapy dog will be working with students. The dog will also work with their handler to provide assistance for students including, but not limited to, effort, participation, social awareness, confidence, engagement and belief in their power to succeed.

### 3. I am worried about allergies. Is this concern being considered?

Mrs. Petrozzi coordinates with our school nurse to be aware of students who have allergies. Please reach out if additional concerns are present.

# 4. My child is afraid of dogs. What should I do?
