

Q1 How did you vote on the proposed budget?

Q2 Why did you vote the way you did on the proposed budget? (Check all that apply)







Q4 What age group applies to you?





Q5 Do you have children currently attending Ken-Ton Schools?





Q6 If yes, check all that apply




