Suspicious Vehicle

On May 13, 2020, at approximately 9:10 p.m., The Town of Tonawanda Police Department received a call for service on Bathurst Dr. for the past tense report of a suspicious vehicle.

It was reported that: at approximately 11:00 a.m. on May 13, 2020, a black van, driven by a white male with a white female passenger, was in the area of Bathurst Dr. The vehicle pulled to the side of the roadway and the female passenger asked a juvenile to go for a ride. The juvenile declined and the van left the area.

On May 15, 2020, The Town of Tonawanda Police Department received information that a black Hyundai minivan was observed on Bathurst Drive on May 14, 2020. The van was described as a "newer" model, with dark tinted windows and a yellow license plate. It was said to have been driven by a white female with a white male passenger, both described to be in their late thirties or early forties.
