#### The Olduvai Gorge

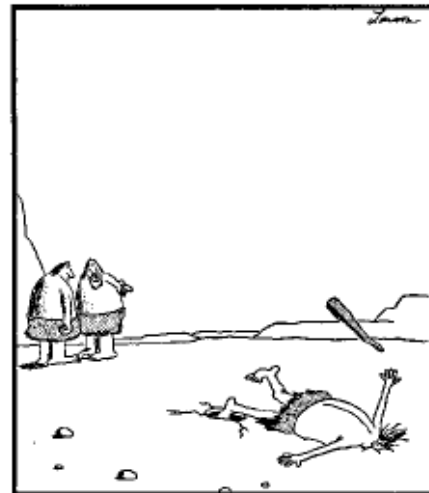

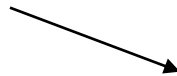
