<u>Procedure:</u> The Journal counts as 30% of your overall course grade each Marking Period which are due roughly every 5 weeks. Each Entry is required to be 1.5 College Size Pages in length graded on Accuracy and Depth of the Topic (citing a minimum of 5 examples from corresponding texts), Creativity (how you decide to tell your story), and Realism (associated with experiences and the mindsets of the men and women enlisted in the military). In addition, be sure to Date / Number each entry before ending with your Rank and Signature.
