




Budget Timeline


Budget Development Timeline




Revenues & Expenditures





Property Taxes

Estimated Tax Levy: 2017-18 School Year

• Tax Levy: \$82,390,409

Property Tax Relief Credit

Established in 2015-16 budget

Valid 2016-17 through 2019-20 school years

Eligibility:

- Receiving STAR exemption or STAR credit
- Resident of New York State
- Gross income no greater than \$275,000
- School district is "tax cap compliant"

Property Tax Relief Credit

Property Tax Relief Credit Amounts 2017-18:

Basic STAR tax savings multiplied by percentage:

Qualified Gross Income in 2015	Percentage	
Not over \$75,000	28%	
Over \$75,000 but not over \$150,000	20.5%	
Over \$150,000 but not over \$200,000	13%	
Over \$200,000 but not over \$275,000	5.5%	
Over \$275,000	0%	

Enhanced STAR tax savings multiplied by 26%

Proposition 1: Budget: \$160,656,978

Proposition 2: Bus Purchase

10 Year Replacement Cycle:

8, 65 Passenger Buses

6, 30 Passenger Buses

Total Proposition:

\$950,520

\$373,793

\$1,324,313

Approximately 70% State Transportation Aided District Share: Approximately \$397,294

What Happens if the Budget is NOT Approved by the Public?

Two Options:

- Resubmit the original budget or submit a revised budget to the voters on the third Tuesday in June OR
- 2. Adopt a contingency budget that levies a tax no greater than that of the current year (0% increase in the tax levy).

If the resubmitted/revised budget proposal is not approved by the required margin:

The Board of Education <u>must adopt a budget that levies a tax no greater than that of</u>
the current year (0% increase tax levy) and the budget would be subject to contingent
budget requirements.

Districts will <u>not</u> be allowed to increase the tax levy to the extent necessary to fund items of expenditure excluded from the tax cap

- No growth factor
- No capital, court order/judgments or pension exclusions
