

ABOUT REGISTRATION FOR NEW YORK STATE HISTORY DAY

- You must complete the Online Registration by March 29, 2015 for the New York State History Day competition in order to be eligible to participate on Monday, April 18, 2016.
- The entry fee is \$20.00 per student.
- Each student who will be competing at New York State History Day either as an individual or as part of a group must register using the Online Registration system. In other words, each member of a group must complete his or her own registration.
- Students should not use the Online Registration system until their teacher/adult sponsor
 has set up their entry in the system. Teachers: please contact the New York State
 History Day office for instructions about setting up Online Registration for your students
- Registration Forms must be completed by March 29, 2016. We will not be able to accept late registrations.

- Once you have completed your Online Registration and submitted payment, you will receive an email confirmation letter. It may take up to five business days for your registration to be completely processed and an email confirmation to be sent.
 Please wait five business days before calling the office to inquire about entry receipt.
- A quick word about the *Entry Information*: If you are a member of a group entry,
 make sure that every member of your group logs on to register. If you find that you
 have been listed with the incorrect group members or if you are missing a group
 member on your confirmation, please *notify your teacher*.
- When you arrive at New York State History Day, you must also register on-site at the Main Barn of The Farmers' Museum to receive your final judging schedule and other important information. On-site registration will be held Sunday, April 17, 3:00 pm 7:30 pm and Monday, April 18, 7:00 am 12:00 noon.

WELCOME BARBEQUE

- You and your teacher, family, friends, and chaperones are invited to a Welcome Barbeque on Sunday evening, April 17, from 4:00p.m. - 7:00p.m.
- The cost is \$10 per person. You must register for this event using the online registration system.
- The barbeque menu includes all beef burgers, Hebrew National Hotdogs, Tyson all Natural Chicken Breast etc., salads, desert and beverages. Gluten free, kosher and vegetarian options available.
- Barbeque cancellations must be made in writing before April 9, 2016. The New York State Historical Association is unable to provide refunds after April 9, 2016.

How to Use the Online Registration System:

Simply follow these easy steps to register for New York State History Day!

- 1. Obtain your 4-digit registration code from your teacher.
- 2. Log on to: http://www.nyshistoryday.org/
- 3. On the main page, click on the Registering for New York State History Day icon
- 4. You should now see a page that says "Welcome to Online Registration!" The instructions on the page, in addition to these steps, will help you navigate the system.
- 5. Click the link that reads "2016 New York State History Day."
- 6. You should now be on a page with a drop-down menu. Select "Competing Student" and click "Submit."
- 7. Click on "Don't have a username and password? Click here to begin." At the "1: Confirm Your Identity" screen, choose NY from the drop down menu, then type your last name and 4 digit code in the boxes. Click "Submit." If you registered using the online system for your regional contest please use the same username and password that you created before.
- 8. The page should say "2: Is This You?" If you see your full name below, click the green "yes." (If it isn't you, or if you get a message saying there were no matches, contact your teacher and have him or her check your info using their log in.)
- 9. The page should now say "3. Establish Your Account Username and Password."

 Do what the screen tells you to do, then click "Submit."
- 10. You should now be on a page that says "Welcome to Online Registration for 2015 New York State History Day." There will be a lot of important information at the top. Please take the time to read this page.
- 11. Registration has been divided into 3 steps. Let's start with STEP 1: STUDENT INFORMATION: Part A. You will see a series of links below the heading. Any link that has a red asterisk in front of it MUST be completed. Links without asterisks are optional.
- 12. Click on the first link "Who Are You:" This will take you to a page where you must type in information. You only have to complete the forms with asterisks. When you are done, click "SAVE." You should now see a green check mark next to the link.
- 13. Click on the "Statement of Originality" link. Read this statement. If this statement is true and you would like to compete, select "Yes" from the drop down menu. Then click "SAVE" in order to continue.
- 14. Click on the title of your entry under the "Entry Information" heading. Check to make sure the information your teacher entered is correct. Add a brief description. This will help the state office know if you qualify for Special Awards. Type your special needs, if any. Please know that we may not be able to accommodate all of your needs. See the contest rulebook for the list of what the state competition will provide; we will contact you before the contest if we can't meet your need.

- 15. Move on to STEP 2: PARENT/GUARDIAN, FAMILY AND FRIEND INFORMATION.

 This is important! You need your parent or legal guardian to complete the "Register a Parent/Other" and "Parent/Guardian Permission for Student Participation" areas in order to complete your registration.
- 16. Move on to STEP 3: CONTEST EXTRAS. This step allows you and your family to register for the Welcome Barbeque. Click the "Optional Events and Activities you and/or your parents/Guardian would like to attend" link. If you are going to attend, click the box under your name. If you would like to purchase additional tickets, put the number in the proper box. (Do not count yourself in this number!) Also, you DO NOT need to provide the names of the attendees in the text box. Leave the text box blank and click "SAVE."
- 17. When all the boxes in front of each field have green check boxes, you can complete your registration by clicking "Confirm Registration and Review Fee Summary." If the system doesn't have all the info it needs, it will tell you what you have to go back and fix. If your registration is complete, you will be at the payment screen. Below a bunch of text you should see a box with your name in it.
- 18. If you or a parent/guardian are paying for your entry fee: Click the box under your name and click "Click to Save and Continue." You can pay one of two ways:
 - a. Using **Visa, MasterCard, American Express, or Discover** to make a secure payment online. Just click the **Credit Card** box and follow the prompts.
 - b. Mailing in a check. Click the Check box and follow the prompts
- 19. If your school district is going to pay for your entry fee: Click "Return to Registration" and then "Finished for now? Save and Log Out." Notify your teacher that you have completed the registration form so that your teacher can submit the fee for your entry.
- 20. When your entry fee payment is received and processed, you will receive an email confirmation of your registration. It can take up to 5 business days to receive a confirmation email, and even longer if you pay by check. Please note that the system will not send a confirmation email until payment is received. If your school is paying with a purchase order, this means payment may not be received before the day of the contest. If you have concerns about your registration status, please contact our office.

Cooperstown is located in central New York, 70 miles west of Albany and 30 miles south of the New York State Thruway.

- From the east or north: New York State Thruway exit 25A, I-88 to Duanesburg, west on Route 20 to Route 80, south on Route 80 to Cooperstown.
- From the south: 1-88 from Binghamton, exit 17 to Route 28, north on Route 28 to Cooperstown.
- From the southeast: New York State Thruway exit 21 at Catskill, Route 23 west, Route 145 north, Route 20 west, Route 80 south to Cooperstown. Or, New York State Thruway exit 21, Route 23 west, I-88 east. Exit 17, Route 28 north to Cooperstown.
- From the west or north: New York State Thruway exit 30 at Herkimer, Route 28 south to Cooperstown. Or New York State Thruway exit 30, Route 28 south, Route 20 east, Route 80 south to Cooperstown.


STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT

As guests of the New York State Historical Association and the Village of Cooperstown, students are expected to abide by the following Code of Conduct:

- Students agree not to abuse, vandalize or steal any property or service.
- Students agree not to possess any weapons, firecrackers, or other flammable materials.
- Students agree not to physically harm, threaten, or harass any person, nor provoke and/or engage in physical fights or malicious pranks.
- Students agree not to tamper with museum or hotel fire systems or fire safety equipment, nor shall students set or fuel a fire of any size.
- Students agree to abide by all History Day rules as set forth in the National History Day Contest Rule Book.

Students who violate any aspect of the Code of Conduct will be subject to punishment, up to and including financial restitution, and may be sent home at parents' expense. In addition, students in violation of the Code of Conduct are subject to disqualification from New York State History Day. Student winners who are found in violation of contest rules and/or the Code of Conduct will not represent New York State at the National Contest at the University of Maryland.


