Memorandum of Agreement

Kenmore Tonawanda Union Free School District ("District," hereafter), by its Superintendent of Schools ("Superintendent," hereafter) and the Kenmore-Tonawanda Union Free School Employees' Association ("Association," hereafter), by its President, each for good and valuable consideration, hereby agree as follows:

WHEREAS, the District has an obligation to provide a minimum of two hundred forty-eight (248) duty days for Core employees according to Section 8.22 of the Collective Bargaining Agreement for the 2017-2018 school year; and

WHEREAS, the District is able to provide two hundred forty-seven (247) duty days for Core employees during the 2017-2018 school year during employee's normal work schedule; and

NOW THEREFORE, the parties agree that:

- 1. Neither the District nor the Association are interested in going to arbitration to resolve the issue for the 2017-2018 school year.
- 2. KTSEA Core employees are entitled to two additional paid Core half-days to be used while students are not in session (during the months of July or August or during the Winter or Spring recess periods).
- 3. KTSEA Core employees will submit a leave-request in Kronos using the code for "CORE," and the leave must be completed and approved by the department supervisor.
- 4. This Memorandum of Agreement shall remain in effect until a successor agreement is reached when the District is unable to provide the minimum of two hundred forty-eight (248) duty days for Core employees.
