My students need materials such as wicker baskets, sheet protectors, paper, and pencils to organize a poetry/creative writing center to nurture a creative learning culture.

My Students

I'm interested in closing the learning gap, meeting student needs, increasing communication, collaboration and motivation within my classroom with a range of reading and learning ability. Creating a culture for learning through motivating experiences speaks volumes to this group of students! Classroom approaches involving more teacher to student coaching, peer coaching, and small group interactions are the answer to increasing. We have a flexible seating environment, which promotes choice and interaction with others. This is NOT the traditional student desk and chair design classroom model. I want to create a motivating free choice center for publication of their interest area...poetry writing.

My Project

My students are eagerly attracted to various poetry activities we do in class for listening pleasure or comprehension related to standards-based curriculum connections. They have had folk tales such as Paul Bunyan or bios about people such as Harriet Tubman come alive through poetry connections.

Poetry has been the main vehicle through which my students are motivated to learn and apply word study, as well as understand concepts such as alliteration and author's point of view.

They voted on the subject for a new classroom free choice center. Hands down, it was poetry they can publish to give to friends or family and for creative expression. These materials will help to organize and give a published look to their creations!

My students will create albums of their poetry to share with families and each other using plastic sheet protectors to add to 3 ring binders. Their work will be protected this way, but also can be more flexibly rearranged if they decide to change their poetry publications in any way. The composition books will be used for planning and drafting, but also some students prefer this a way to record their work. I'd like this center to be equipped with enough pencils on hand to keep them working all year, and the wicker baskets will stand out as uniquely for this center (since they are different from other storage in the classroom) to store paper and other supplies for writing/illustrating their creations.
