As a third year student, you are expected to:

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- Follow your interests in the real world.  
(start informational interviews and shadow days early, secure an LTI by the end of October)
- Have a positive impact on the community  
(volunteer hours, positively represent Big Picture in the community)
- Participate in development and revision of your Learning Plan three times a year.

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- Set daily goals based on your Learning Plan
- Complete the work in your Learning Plan
- Build a working portfolio - save your work!
- Exhibit publicly three times a year
- Prepare for state exam(s).
- Write in your journal at least three times per week
- Show respect for others and yourself.
- Take responsibility for your own learning.
- Be responsible for your location and actions.
- Come to school each day on time; your advisor must be called to report an absence. If you are in an internship, call your mentor as well.
- Read at least one book each trimester outside of required reading, the first one **must** be an autobiography.
- Be a school leader: prepare and facilitate an advisory discussion and a pick-me-up activity.

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- Write at least 15 pages of your autobiography.
- In the fall have your first college-prep meeting.
- By the end of the year get your Senior Thesis Project proposal approved.
- Research three colleges and their requirements. Complete related assignment.
- Attend College Night at your home school.
- Visit at least two colleges.
- Create a draft of a college essay.
- Begin to develop your college portfolio (resume, essay, awards, best work).
- Prepare for PSATs in the fall.
- Prepare for ACT or SAT in the spring.
- Take advantage of opportunities and make summer plans.

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
