As a fourth year student, you are expected to:

- Follow your interests in the real world.
 (start informational interviews and shadow days early, secure an LTI by the end of October)
- Have a positive impact on the community.
 (volunteer hours, positively represent Big Picture in the community)
- Participate in development and revision of your Learning Plan three times a year.
- · Set daily goals based on your Learning Plan
- Complete the work in your Learning Plan
- · Read at least one book each trimester outside of required reading.
- Build a working portfolio save your work!
- · Exhibit publicly three times a year
- Prepare for any remaining state exams you need for graduation.
- Write in your journal at least three times per week
- Be responsible for your location and actions.
- · Show respect for others and yourself.
- Take responsibility for your own learning.
- Complete a 30-40 page autobiography.
- Prepare for and take ACT or SAT in the early fall.
- Complete your college portfolio.
- Visit at least two colleges.
- Research and apply for college.
- Come to school each day on time; your advisor must be called to report an absence. If you are in an internship, call your mentor as well.
- Be a school leader: prepare and facilitate two advisory discussions and two pick-me-up activities.
- Apply for financial aid by the end of April. (Your parents must have their taxes completed first).
- Create a post-high school plan.
- Meet consistently with your Thesis mentor. Show weekly progress on your Thesis project. Complete your in-depth Senior Thesis Project.
- Present your work and reflection at a graduation exhibition.
- Take advantage of opportunities and make summer plans.
