CLASSROOM POLICIES

Required materials

- 1. <u>CALCULATORIII</u> You need a basic 4 function calculator or a scientific calculator no graphing calculators are allowed in to the Chemistry regents exam. I will **not** provide a calculator for you to use on tests, quizzes or exams.

Homework:

Homework assignments will be given with each unit. Homework is expected to be done **INDIVIDUALLY**. If you have difficulty with an assignment please come see me for help.

Incomplete assignments will be given half credit. Assignments turned in after the class period will be considered late and no credit will be given. Assignments not turned in will receive a zero. Do your homework and turn it in on time.

Absences and Making up work:

Each student is expected to be in class on time everyday. If you are absent it is **YOUR** responsibility to determine what you have missed. You are responsible for making up all homework, tests, and quizzes.

Students will be given one school day after their absence to make up a test, quiz or homework assignment. If you are absent the day an assignment is due it is due the day you return at the beginning of class. If you are absent from class for more than two consecutive days, it is up to **YOU** to make arrangements with me to set a due date for the assignments that have been missed. If you do not talk to me about the make-up work, I will assume you are not going to turn it in and you will receive a zero.

Worksheets will be in the bin at the back of the room. There are 5 folders one for each day so if you miss Monday you can get the worksheets you missed in the folder marked MONDAY.

Unit Tests:

There will be a full period test at the end of each unit. Every effort will be made for you to have a review period before the test is given. All unit tests will consist of multiple choice and constructed response questions, similar to the Regents exam.

Quizzes:

Quizzes will be given periodically throughout the course of a unit. Various formats will be used as well as multiple choice.
