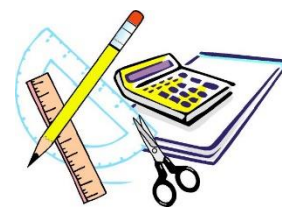




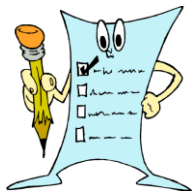
Math Policy

10% Responsibility:

Entering Class:

- Read what is on the projected screen or board.
- Put homework in appropriate spot!
- Complete the practice problems that are assigned. **Please show work.** These sheets are collected for a grade.
- Record information in your agenda. “Remind” app is used to post daily assignments and information. “Remind” direction sheet is attached.
- **Absent:** You need to check your class period’s pocket when you return - located under sign “While you were out”

30% Assignments (in/out) class:

- Homework assignments from the textbook will be done on a separate sheet of paper with a proper heading and in pencil. If the homework is a worksheet you may show work on the sheet unless you are asked to use a separate sheet of paper. All daily homework assignments are due the next day.
- If you were absent when work was handed in, please write “absent” at the top.
- **LATE** work: 1 day late -earn up to 75%, 2 days late - earn up to 50%, after 2 days = a zero.
- Textbook -Show work and take notes in your textbook which will help with homework.

40% Assessments:

- You will be informed in advance about any formative (graded) testing.

20% Weekly Skills Practice:

- Monday- pick up skill worksheet in class and is due the following Monday. I hope to post skills sheets on website.

Checking your progress/Grades:

- You should be checking your grades at least once a week on Infinite Campus.
- You will get a 5 week report (progress) and a report card every 10 weeks.

FYI:

Midterm in January will count as a regular test score.

Final Exam in June: Review sheets start at the end of May and exam will count as a 5th quarter grade.

We try to do math “sprints” at the end of math class on Fridays to help for fluency of basic skills.
