## 2023-2024 Hoover Middle School Music Commitment/Registration Form

Dear Parent or Guardian,
The music faculty at Hoover Middle School is starting to prepare for next year's musical ensembles. Orchestra, band and chorus are all year-long commitments that meet every other day for the entire school year, rotating with their other special area classes.

For scheduling and staffing reasons, it is important that we know which music courses your child is interested in participating in for the 2022-2023 school year. We must account for everyone. Please return the completed form below to your child's music teacher no later than May 17,2023. While we need our registration to be as complete as possible, we understand that circumstances do change; therefore, the final day to drop or add a course is the end of the $1^{\text {st }}$ week of school on September 8, 2023.

Students that would like to participate in an instrumental AND vocal group may do so. The directors have a system in place wherein these students go to each group on alternate days of the 4 day cycle. It is also important to note that if a student chooses to participate in a performing ensemble, they must participate in all requirements of the class, such as a pull-out lesson once a week (band and orchestra only) and 2-3 evening concerts, per group, throughout the year.

The district policy for students in grades 5-12 is that each student is expected to provide their own instrument - either by rental from a music store or purchase. The only instruments that are guaranteed to be rented out from the school (for a $\$ 40$ rental fee) are: piccolo, oboe, bassoon, bass clarinet, tenor saxophone, baritone saxophone, french horn, baritone/euphonium, tuba and string bass. Students that play the trombone or cello will be provided with one for use in school, but should obtain their own for at home practice from a music store. Instruments that are too large for the bus (tenor saxophone, baritone saxophone, baritone/euphonium, tuba and string bass) may pay one $\$ 40$ rental fee to the district and will receive one instrument for use at home and one to use at school.
