

Ken-Ton Schools UPK Registration 2025-2026 School Year

Dear Ken-Ton Community,

The Kenmore Town of Tonawanda Union Free School District and the Ken-Ton YMCA are happy to announce that the 2025-2026 Registration for Half-Day and Full-Day Universal Preschool Program (UPK) will be open to all Ken-Ton families starting on March 1, 2025. UPK is a special program funded by the New York State Education Department to provide an early learning experience for the children of eligible families. The traditional classroom-based UPK framework is designed to introduce academics and enhance socialization, physical activity, communication, creative thinking, and prepare your child for kindergarten.

To be eligible for UPK in the 2025-2026 school year which begins in September 2025, children must be 4 years of age on or before December 1, 2025 (a child cannot turn 5 years of age between December 2, 2024, through and including December 1, 2025 to be eligible for UPK).

Locations:

- Hamilton Elementary
 - o Full-Day classes only
- Holmes Elementary
 - 1 Half-Day class (AM or PM option)

Session Information:

- Half-Day class: 2.5 hours long AM and PM Options
- Full-Day class: 6 hours long
- Start times will be staggered between
 8:30am-9:15am based on classroom placement

** Families will be responsible for Transportation to and from the UPK Program **

There is limited availability for the program based on grant funding. This funding allows us to enroll a limited number of students during the 2025-2026 school year. If more children apply than there are available slots, the district will hold a random selection process in the form of a lottery.

Ken-Ton will continue to accept applications until May 23, 2025. This is not a first come, first served process. If we receive more applications (half day and full day) than our cap allows, the school district will conduct a virtual random lottery on Wednesday, June 4, 2025 at 4pm. All completed applications received by May 23, 2025 will be included in the lottery.

You must be a resident of the district by May 23, 2025 to be included in the lottery. Your child must be up-to-date with New York State vaccination requirements and have an updated physical for the school nurse.

Registration may be completed through the Ken-Ton School District Central Registration Department, located at 1500 Colvin Blvd, Buffalo, NY 14223.
