



Ken-Ton Schools UPK Registration

Dear Ken-Ton Community,

The Kenmore-Town of Tonawanda Union Free School District and the Ken-Ton YMCA are happy to announce that the 2024-2025 Registration for Half-Day and Full-Day Universal Preschool Program (UPK) will be open to all Ken-Ton families starting on March 1, 2024. UPK is a special program funded by the New York State Education Department to provide an early learning experience for the children of eligible families. The traditional classroom-based UPK framework is designed to introduce academics and enhance socialization, physical activity, communication, creative thinking, and prepare your child for kindergarten.

To be eligible for UPK in the 2024-25 school year which begins in September 2024, children must be 4 years of age on or before December 1, 2024 (a child cannot turn 5 years of age between December 2, 2023, through and including December 1, 2024 to be eligible for UPK).

There is limited availability for the program based on grant funding. This funding allows us to enroll a limited number of students during the 2024-2025 school year. If more children apply than there are available slots, the district will hold a random selection process in the form of a lottery.

Ken-Ton will continue to accept applications until May 24, 2024. This is not a first come, first served process. If we receive more applications (half day and full day) than our cap allows, the school district will conduct a virtual random lottery on Wednesday, June 5 at 4pm. All completed applications received by May 2024, will be included in the lottery.

You must be a resident of the district by May 24, 2024 to be included in the lottery. Your child must be up-to-date with New York State vaccination requirements.
