II. Faulty Report:

- Major changes in the curriculum beginning with a name change to World Languages Department, formerly Language Other Than English
- West has already begun implementing many of the changes
- Changes will be implemented District wide beginning in 2023 with 7th and 8th grades
- NYS will now be aligned with the National Standards
- Changes include updating modern themes and topics and ways of communication

- Changes to & streamline of accelerated programs 9th will be Pre AP World with expectation to take AP World or 10 Regents; if students don't want IB or AP then looking to offer college credit classes through SUNY or program from Syracuse University
- Next year will be offering a half year Women's Studies elective with plan to expand women and gender studies
- KenTon will pilot "Seal of Civic Readiness" where students will earn credits to graduate with a Seal from the social studies department
 - Meant for all students, not just those in the accelerated programs, and there will be many different ways to achieve
 - The program will be shaped and molded for success
 - o Beginning next year with 9th graders and will be open to 9th, 10th, 11th & 12th

- Algebra now encompasses Algebra I; Algebra A & Algebra B (culminating with Algebra I Regents exam); Algebra 2; Algebra 2A & Algebra 2B(culminating with Algebra II Regents exam); and Algebra 2H
- Algebra A & Algebra B are taken over the course of two years, same with Algebra 2A & Algebra 2B. Those that take 1A & 1B do not normally take 2A & 2B
