

# Your child has been enrolled in the Kenton 2022 Elementary Summer School Franklin Elementary School T-Th July 5-7 M-Th July 11- Aug 4

This summer we will use Scholastic Reading's Lit Camp to engage and inspire your child to read and write. Working through a series of badges, our program will focus on creating positive learning experiences as we combine academics with social emotional wellness in a literacy framework. These components, combined with daily specials (art, music, PE, STEM) will give your child a well-balanced day. We've got some surprises planned as well!



## **The Summer Session Day:**

Hours: 8:30 a.m. to 2:00pm Monday-Thursday

**Transportation:** Summer Bus Information will be sent home the last week in June/first week in July. The Kenton transportation department is working to make pickups and dropoffs as close to home/daycare as possible. Please let Ken-Ton Transportation know of any changes ASAP (874-8611).



<u>Alternative Bus Drop-Off</u>: If you are requesting your child be dropped off at a location other than your home you must complete an Alternate Drop Off Form found on the Ken-Ton District Website (<u>www.ktufsd.org</u>), and turned into Transportation. Alternative requests are accepted for the full M-Th week only and not for individual days.

### **Program Basics:**

**<u>Breakfast</u>** will be available to our students during the summer school program. All students are eligible for **FREE** breakfast which will be served in the classroom upon arrival.



**Lunch**: Each student will also receive a **FREE** lunch served by the cafeteria each day of the program. Students are also welcome to bring a bagged lunch.

**Snack:** With an extended day this year, students are encouraged to bring a water bottle and a snack.

**Student participation** greatly affects your child's success! Each day is filled with a camp-fire roundup, interesting read-alouds and activities your child will not want to miss!

**Behavior expectations:** The summer school session is 19 days long. To increase instructional time and provide a positive classroom climate, we maintain very high expectations for students to follow classroom procedures and display appropriate behavior. We will follow the **KTUFSD SAVE Policy and Dignity for All Students Act.** Students not complying with these guidelines will be subject to appropriate consequences, which may include exclusion from the summer school program.

#### Name Tags

Please make sure that your child wears the sticker name tag on the first day of school.

# **Daily Arrival Routine:**

#### **Driven students** should arrive between 8:15-8:30am

- You may drop off your child at the front of the school on Parkhurst Road. Staff will be available to assist the children.
- Please avoid parking in the area where there are cones (just before the bus loop). The cones are there so that our buses can make a safe turn into the bus loop.
- Once buses have exited, we will remove the cones so that you may utilize the bus loop. We
  ask that you please do not pull in the bus loop until our buses have left. If you pull in the
  bus loop with the buses, you will become stuck in the bus loop until all buses have dropped
  off and left the building.
- Please be respectful of our neighbors and do not block or park in their driveways.
- If you want to walk your child to the door, you must park on **Parkhurst Blvd** and walk.

#### Bussed Students will arrive at Franklin by 8:25

- Bussed students will be dropped off in the bus loop in front of the school.
- All bussed students will use door #1 for arrival.



### **Daily Dismissal Routine:**

**ALL car riders and walkers** must be picked up and signed out promptly at 1:55pm.

Adults should arrive at Door #3 on the Franklin Middle School Side. Photo
Identification is required when picking up a student. Adults picking up children should
not use the bus loop. Parents must park on Parkhurst Blvd or side streets.

**Bussers** will leave Franklin by 2:00 pm daily.

**Early Dismissal:** Students picked up early must have a note or guardians must call the office. The authorized adult should meet the child at **Door #1**. **Photo identification is required.** If it is not dismissal time, you may use the bus loop to park.


