

Elementary Digital Reading & Math Programs Available this Summer

Throughout the home learning phase, your child has had access to a number of math and reading digital resources. Over the past few weeks, many parents have asked if students would be able to continue to access them over the summer months. While district-loaned devices are not available for the summer months, we are pleased to inform you that your child will be able to continue accessing all the great learning programs they've already used in distance learning on your home devices. Students may continue to log in through Clever (www.ktufsd.org/clever) to access the following programs:











The Scholastic Literacy Digital Resources will continue to help all students learn to read with fluency, comprehension, and enjoyment. For students who were unable to complete the mathematics content for their grade level, Zearn lessons will still be available so they can prepare for the coming school year. IXL will remain as a resource for continuing to practice and develop math understanding.

Student use of these learning resources will not be graded, required, or monitored. District loaned devices are not available over the summer. Any parents and families may, at their discretion, choose to use these tools in order to reduce the risk of academic regression that typically takes place during the summer months, and to ensure that your child is ready to hit the ground running in September.
