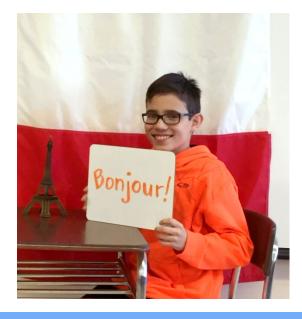

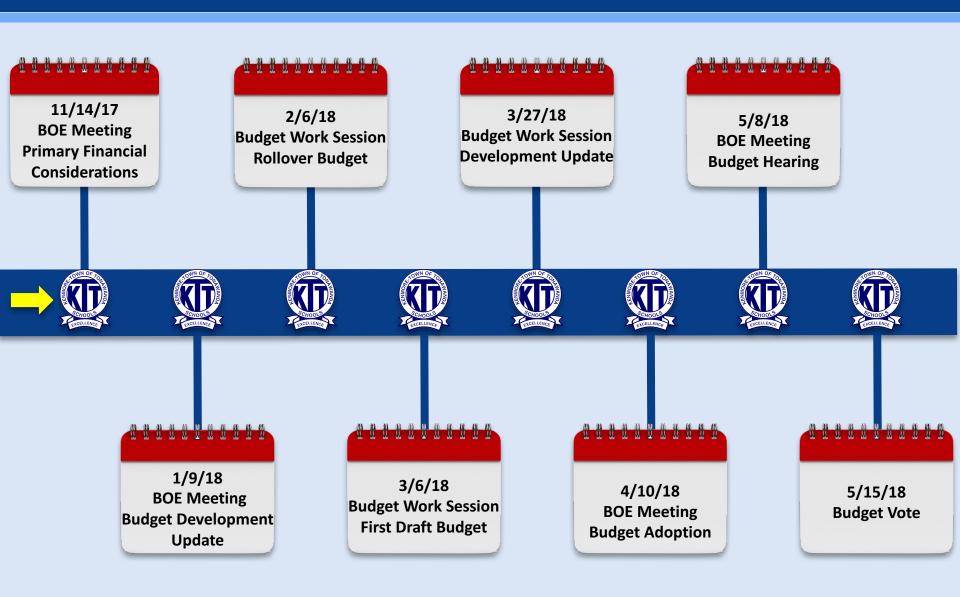

# Revenue Budget



#### Revenue Budget: State Aid

#### Current Fiscal Year Performance

- Current fiscal status
  - \$36.1 billion in total tax collections
  - Down 2.1% from last year
- Division of Budget
  - Projecting \$4 billion shortfall for next year

#### **Revenue Budget: Other Factors**

- Foundation Aid
- Federal funding & Medicaid
  - \$2.6 \$17 billion cuts to New York State
- Sales tax (Erie County)
  - Reduced for 2017-18 but showing slight recovery
- Electric Generation Facility Cessation Mitigation Program
  - 60% of lost revenue
  - Estimated \$1.7 million
- Increase in building aid ratio
- Sale of Philip Sheridan

#### Revenue Budget: Property Tax

#### Tax Levy Limit

- 2% or rate of inflation (CPI), whichever is lower
- Early Estimates
  - CPI: Trending towards 2%
  - Monthly % change no more than .3% decrease
- Exclusions for Formula
  - Capital Exclusions \$1.9 million local share increase
- Keeping Debt Service level

#### **Expenditure Budget**

#### Contractual Increases

- KTA contract extension
- KTSEA contract extension

#### **Benefit Increases**

- Health insurance costs to remain stable
- Plan has been performing well

#### **Expenditure Budget – Retirement Systems**

#### **Employee Retirement System (ERS)**

- Currently 15.3%
- Expected rate: 14.9%

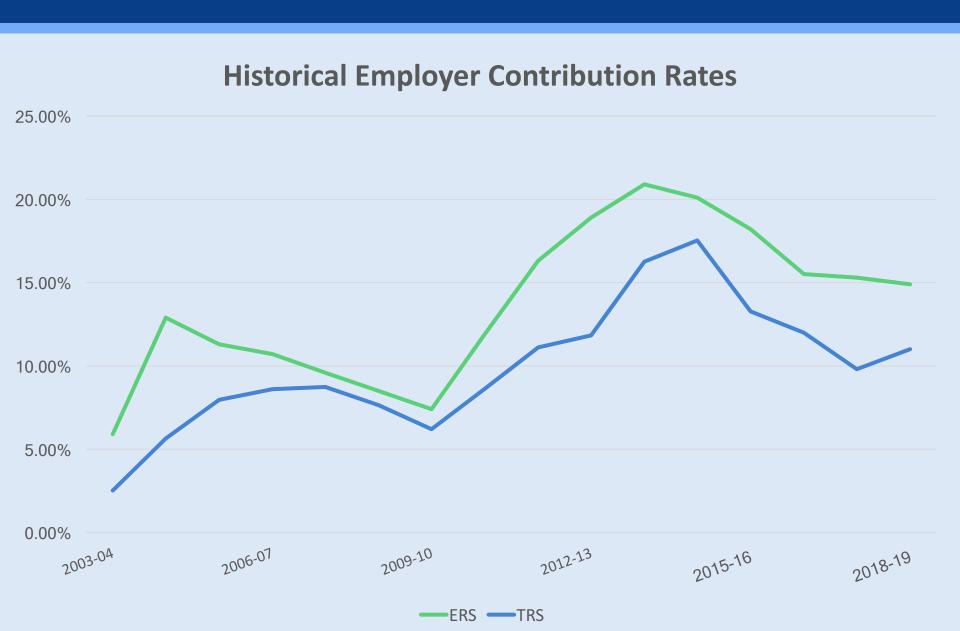


#### Teacher's Retirement System (TRS)

- Currently 9.8%
- Expected range: 10.5 11%
