

My students need shampoo, deodorant, tissues, body wash, tooth brushes, and toothpaste.

#### My Students

Iraq, Yemen, Turkey, Puerto Rico, Vietnam, Burma, and Jordan are a handful of the places my students have come from. The majority of my students came from countries that are not safe. Some have lived in refugee camps and others haven't been able to attend school in years.

These children and their families come to America to create a better life.

These families priorities are often finding a place to live and a way to make money. Often times they don't have toothbrushes, toothpaste, feminine products, shampoo, conditioner, tissues, etc. Coming to a new school without being able to speak the language is stressful enough but then add in bad breath and not being able to take a shower and we are just setting the students up to fail.

#### My Project

These students are often coming from living in refugee camps. They are struggling to adapt to a foreign culture, new city, and an unknown language. Hygiene isn't always at the forefront of their minds. These products will be for students to use at school (the tooth paste, toothbrushes, floss, and tissues) or to bring home (shampoo, body wash, conditioner, etc.).

Students can't focus on their education if they aren't feeling clean and well taken care of.

When students show up to school without having brushed their teeth or taken a shower, we can offer them these products so they can feel better.
