### General School Rules

5. You must have your school agenda and student ID with you at all times! If you lose your agenda, you are expected to replace it immediately (replacement cost is \$6.00). Failure to have your agenda may result in disciplinary action, and you will not be allowed to leave your classes for any reason!
6. Dress appropriately. Hoodies, coats/jackets, and extremely baggy, tight, or revealing clothes are not allowed to be worn during school hours. If you wear clothes that are inappropriate for school, you will be asked to change and may also face disciplinary action. Please be sensible!
7. Cell phone or any other electronic devices must be **TURNED OFF** during school hours. You may have them with you, but if you are caught using them for any reason (talking, text messaging, checking for messages, games, etc.) it will be taken from you and will result in disciplinary action.
8. Hats, backpacks, headphones, MP3 players and any other electronic device are not allowed to be used during school hours (7:50-dismissal) and should be kept in your locker or concealed during the day.
