If you are going to purchase an instrument, please contact Mr. Aguglia to help you make a good decision. paguglia@ktufsd.org</p> <p>Single Reeds- generally one box of ten per semester</p> <p>Saxes- should get 2.5 strength Rico royals (blue box).</p> <p>Clarinets- Mitchell Laurie 2.5-3 strength.</p> <p>Double Reeds: I recommend going online to: www.Millermarketingco.com</p> <p>Oboes-Miller select reserve oboe reeds (always have three good ones)</p> <p>Bassoons- JBRF artist bassoon reeds fire fox batons (always have three good ones)</p> <p>Tuner- everyone needs a tuner! You don't need to spend a lot. Usually under \$25 or a free phone app will suffice.</p> <p>Books- all band students use method books. Students will be assessed in September and then told which book to purchase. Parents will need to purchase the appropriate books at that time. 100% of lesson materials come from these books. Expect the cost to be \$13 plus shipping.</p> <p>Attire – Grade 8 & 9 ensembles will wear all black. Details of this will be in the handbook on the first day of school.</p>
