Course Cancellations

In the event of insufficient enrollment, classes will be cancelled three (3) school business days before the start date. You will be notified by email or phone. Full refunds will be issued in the event of such cancellation. If original payment was made by cash or check, a refund check will be processed. For payment by credit card, a refund will be issued to your account if original payment was within 120 days. If over, a check will be issued.

Late Registration

Registering on or after the first scheduled day of class is permitted if space is available, however class fees will not be prorated. If registering late, it must be done through our office during regular business hours.

Refunds & Transfers

Requests for refunds or transfers must be made to the Community Education office at least three (3) business days before the scheduled start of a course, excluding courses with a specific registration deadline. A medical request for a refund or transfer made after the start of a class will require a doctors note. A \$5.00 processing fee will be applied in all instances.

Residency

Registration for classes is open to all, regardless of residency. A resident, entitled to resident fee prices, is defined as one who lives in and pays taxes to the Kenmore-Town of Tonawanda UFSD. Please call our office prior to registering should you have questions regarding residency.

Gold Card Discount

If you are age 60 and over and reside within the boundaries of the District, you are entitled to Gold Card privileges. Obtaining a Gold Card qualifies the holder for a reduced rate on specified classes. Important message about COVID-19:

Please note, the Community Education Department is taking all necessary precautions when it comes to the health and safety of our instructors, staff, and customers. We've diligently put measures in place to ensure our buildings and grounds are safe.

We ask that you do your part and follow all CDC and DOH guidelines and regulations when it comes to signs and symptoms of illness related to COVID-19.

We've strategically reduced the maximum number of students able to enroll in face-to-face class to ensure social distancing of at least 6 feet can be maintained. We've also modified furniture/room arrangements in classrooms to reduce social density.

We **require** face coverings at all times. Patrons are required to bring their own face mask/covering to the building, PPE is available at the single point of entry if needed. Prior to entering our District buildings for Community Education purposes, instructors and patrons will be required to agree to a mandatory set of health assurances aligned with CDC and DOH guidelines.

Extensive protocols for cleaning and disinfecting will be implemented in all school buildings every day. This includes daily deep cleaning and the use of Protexus electrostatic sprayers, which are advanced applicators that are very effective at quickly killing pathogens including coronavirus, throughout our school buildings. Disinfecting wipes with a 1-minute kill time and hand sanitizer dispensers will be available in every classroom. Extensive use of hand sanitizer and thorough hand washing will be continuously reinforced.

The Erie County Department of Health guidelines currently do not include procedures to shut down a school in the event of a positive test or multiple positive tests. Extensive social distancing measures, PPE usage, and cleaning protocols are being conducted to minimize the risk of exposure. In the event of a positive test, the Department of Health would conduct a case review and contact tracing to determine who was at risk of exposure.

The district will provide and maintain adequate supplies to support healthy hand and respiratory hygiene, including soap, hand sanitizer with at least 60 percent alcohol (for staff and older students who can safely use hand sanitizer), paper towels, tissues, and lined trash receptacles.

Information in this publication may change as we continue to monitor the COVID-19 precautions and safety measures set forth by the CDC and DOH. This information is up to date as of August 28th, 2020.

COVID - 19 PRECAUTIONS

The Erie County Department of Health has provided guidance on contact tracing and testing for school districts in Erie County. If a student or staff member tests positive for COVID-19, the Erie County Department of Health will initiate the process of conducting a case investigation and contact tracing. Contact tracing would identify close contacts (within 6 feet for 10 or more minutes, though other criteria may be considered by contact tracers), and the Department of Health would advise close contacts whether there is a need to quarantine, monitor for symptoms, and/or be tested. Those who do test positive will not be able to return to school for a minimum of 10 days following the onset of symptoms (at least three days without a fever). As a precaution we will place thermal temperature scanners at the Single Point of Entry at Kenmore Middle School.

All staff will be educated to observe students or other staff members for signs of any type of illness such as:

- Flushed cheeks;
- Rapid or difficulty breathing (without recent physical activity);
- Fatigue, and/or irritability; and
- Frequent use of the bathroom.

Face coverings (masks) will be required to be worn at all times. Including, but not limited to:

- Any time students and/or personnel are less than six (6) feet apart from one another.
- Upon entry to the building until arriving in your workspace or classroom.
- While in any common spaces (Hallways, restrooms, entrances, etc.)
- When in tightly confined spaces occupied by more than one individual at a time (elevators, supply closets, etc.)
- Masks will be available for anyone who may not bring their own on any given day.

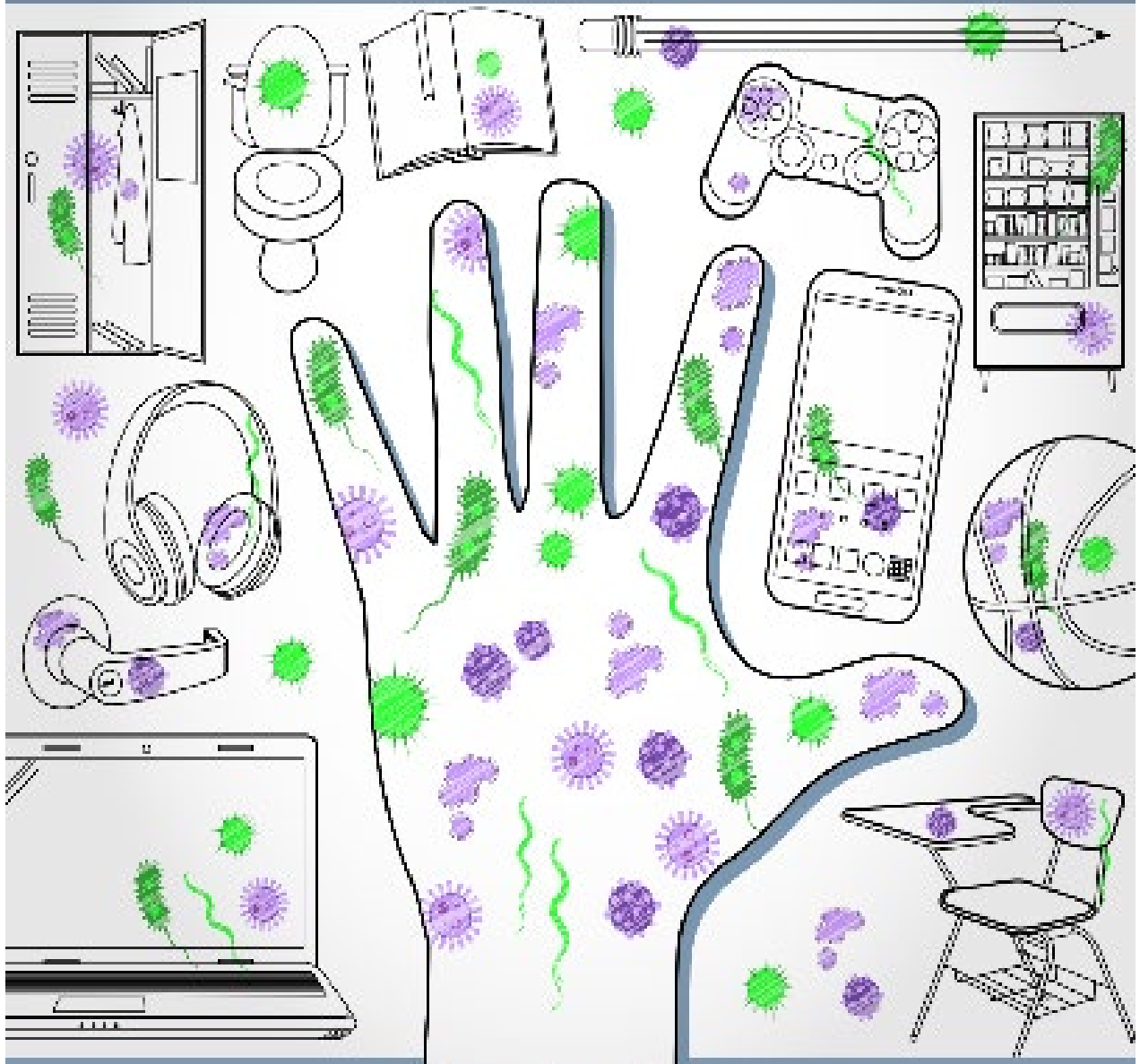
On a daily basis, students (and/or the student's parent/guardian) will be expected to attest to the following statements:

1. Have you experienced any of the following symptoms in the last 14 days: Cough, Shortness of Breath or Trouble Breathing, Fever (above 100° F), Chills, Muscle Pain, Sore Throat, New Loss of Taste or Smell, Nausea, Vomiting, Diarrhea?
2. Have you been in close or proximate contact in the past 14 days with anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19 or who has or had symptoms of COVID-19?
3. Have you tested positive for COVID-19 within the last 14 days?
4. Have you traveled internationally or from a state identified per the New York State Travel Advisory in the past 14 days?

Anyone who responds "yes" to one or more of the health screening questions is expected to stay home and contact their health provider for further instructions. Individuals who were exposed to the COVID-19 virus must complete quarantine, even if they have not developed symptoms before returning to in-person learning. Discharge from quarantine and return to school will be conducted in coordination with the Erie County Health Department.

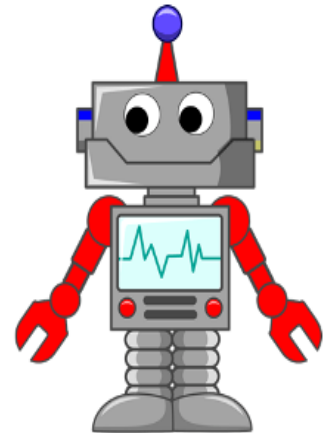

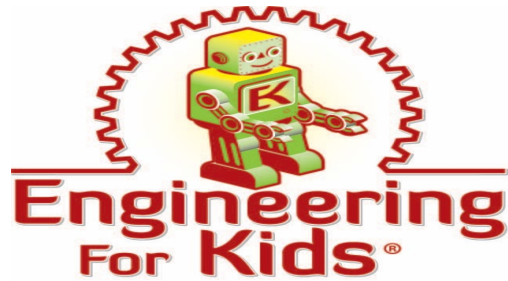

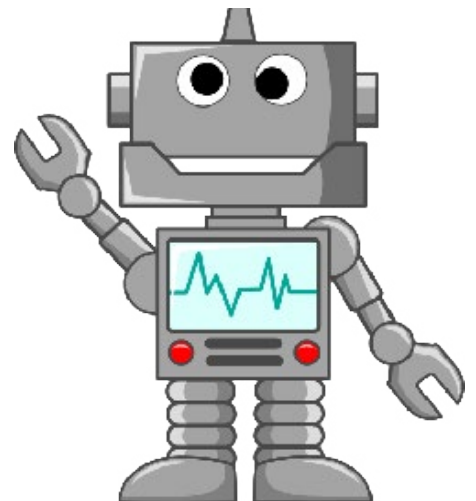

Individuals who were exposed to the COVID-19 virus must complete quarantine, even if they have not developed symptoms before returning to in-person learning. Discharge from quarantine and return to school will be conducted in coordination with the Erie County Health Department.
