Course Confirmations

Due to the volume of registrations processed, we cannot call to confirm your registration. Assume you are registered unless otherwise notified. It is recommended you provide an email address when registering online and you will receive an email confirmation.

Course Cancellations

In the event of insufficient enrollment, classes will be cancelled three (3) school business days before the start date. You will be notified by email or phone. Full refunds will be issued in the event of such cancellation. If original payment was made by cash or check, a refund check will be processed. For payment by credit card, a refund will be issued to your account if original payment was within 120 days. If over, a check will be issued.

Late Registration

Registering on or after the first scheduled day of class is permitted if space is available, however class fees will not be prorated. If registering late, it must be done through our office during regular business hours.

Refunds & Transfers

Requests for refunds or transfers must be made to the Community Education office at least three (3) business days before the scheduled start of a course, excluding courses with a specific registration deadline. A medical request for a refund or transfer made after the start of a class will require a doctors note. A \$5.00 processing fee will be applied in all instances.

Residency

Registration for classes is open to all, regardless of residency. A resident, entitled to resident fee prices, is defined as one who lives in and pays taxes to the Kenmore-Town of Tonawanda UFSD. Please call our office prior to registering should you have questions regarding residency.

Gold Card Discount

If you are age 60 and over and reside within the boundaries of the District, you are entitled to Gold Card privileges. Obtaining a Gold Card qualifies the holder for a reduced rate on specified classes. To obtain a Gold Card, please call our office at (716) 874-8500 to confirm information and activate your Gold Card discount.

Employee Fee

Closings due to inclement weather will be announced on local radio and TV stations. If the Ken-Ton School District is closed during the day, evening programs are also cancelled. In addition, our office is closed. Makeup sessions will be arranged when possible.

Important message about COVID-19:

Please note, the Community Education Department is taking all necessary precautions when it comes to the health and safety of our instructors, staff, and customers. We've diligently put measures in place to ensure our buildings and grounds are safe.

We ask that you do your part and follow all CDC and DOH guidelines and regulations when it comes to signs and symptoms of illness related to COVID-19.

We've strategically reduced the maximum number of students able to enroll in face-to-face class to ensure social distancing of at least 6 feet can be maintained. We've also modified furniture/room arrangements in classrooms to reduce social density.

We **require** face coverings at all times. Patrons are required to bring their own face mask/covering to the building, PPE is available at the single point of entry if needed. Prior to entering our District buildings for Community Education purposes, instructors and patrons will be required to agree to a mandatory set of health assurances aligned with CDC and DOH guidelines.

Extensive protocols for cleaning and disinfecting will be implemented in all school buildings every day. This includes daily deep cleaning and the use of Protexus electrostatic sprayers, which are advanced applicators that are very effective at quickly killing pathogens including coronavirus, throughout our school buildings. Disinfecting wipes with a 1-minute kill time and hand sanitizer dispensers will be available in every classroom. Extensive use of hand sanitizer and thorough hand washing will be continuously reinforced.

The Erie County Department of Health guidelines currently do not include procedures to shut down a school in the event of a positive test or multiple positive tests. Extensive social distancing measures, PPE usage, and cleaning protocols are being conducted to minimize the risk of exposure. In the event of a positive test, the Department of Health would conduct a case review and contact tracing to determine who was at risk of exposure.

The district will provide and maintain adequate supplies to support healthy hand and respiratory hygiene, including soap, hand sanitizer with at least 60 percent alcohol (for staff and older students who can safely use hand sanitizer), paper towels, tissues, and lined trash receptacles.

Information in this publication may change as we continue to monitor the COVID-19 precautions and safety measures set forth by the CDC and DOH. This information is up to date as of March 8th, 2021.

COVID - 19 PRECAUTIONS

The Erie County Department of Health has provided guidance on contact tracing and testing for school districts in Erie County. If a student or staff member tests positive for COVID-19, the Erie County Department of Health will initiate the process of conducting a case investigation and contact tracing. Contact tracing would identify close contacts (within 6 feet for 10 or more minutes, though other criteria may be considered by contact tracers), and the Department of Health would advise close contacts whether there is a need to quarantine, monitor for symptoms, and/or be tested. Those who do test positive will not be able to return to school for a minimum of 10 days following the onset of symptoms (at least three days without a fever). As a precaution we will place thermal temperature scanners at the Single Point of Entry at Kenmore Middle School.

All staff will be educated to observe students or other staff members for signs of any type of illness such as:

- Flushed cheeks;
- Rapid or difficulty breathing (without recent physical activity);
- Fatigue, and/or irritability; and
- Frequent use of the bathroom.

Face coverings (masks) will be required to be worn at all times. Including, but not limited to:

- Any time students and/or personnel are less than six (6) feet apart from one another.
- Upon entry to the building until arriving in your workspace or classroom.
- While in any common spaces (Hallways, restrooms, entrances, etc.)
- When in tightly confined spaces occupied by more than one individual at a time (elevators, supply closets, etc.)
- Masks will be available for anyone who may not bring their own on any given day.

On a daily basis, students (and/or the student's parent/guardian) will be expected to attest to the following statements:

- 1) Have you experienced any of these new or worsening symptoms in the last 10 days: Cough, Shortness of Breath or Trouble Breathing, Fever (greater than or equal to 100° F), Chills, Muscle Pain, Sore Throat, New Loss of Taste or Smell, Nausea, Vomiting, Diarrhea, Headaches, Fatigue/feeling of tiredness or Nasal Congestion/Runny Nose? Note- Please answer 'yes' only if you are experiencing a new onset of symptoms or a change in symptoms from your baseline if you have a diagnosed and documented pre-existing condition such as allergies, asthma.
- 2) In the past 10 days have you been in close contact with anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19?
- 3) Have you tested positive for COVID-19 within the last 10 days?
- 4) Have you traveled internationally to a CDC level 2 or 3 COVID-19 related travel health notice country or from a state or territory identified per the New York State Travel Advisory in the past 10 days?
- 5) Is your temperature at or above 100° F today?

Anyone who responds "yes" to one or more of the health screening questions is expected to stay home and contact their health provider for further instructions. Individuals who were exposed to the COVID-19 virus must complete quarantine, even if they have not developed symptoms before returning to in-person learning. Discharge from quarantine and return to school will be conducted in coordination with the Erie County Health Department.

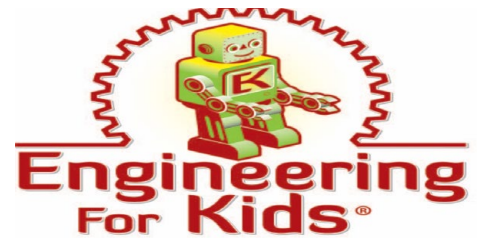

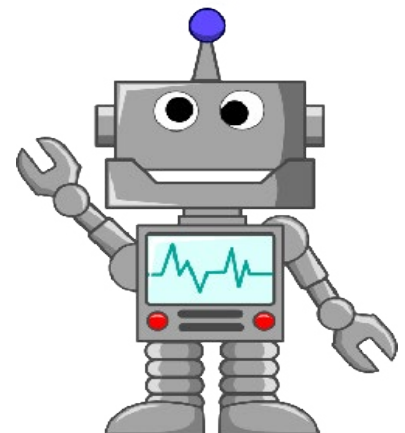

NFL Flag is an excellent alternative to full-contact, full equipment, "6 nights a week" youth football leagues. The game is strictly "no contact" football with primary emphasis placed on the development of passing, receiving, running and coverage skills, and having fun playing football. Games are played 5 on 5 with modified rules to heighten skill development and assure equal playing time for all players. NFL Flag is not a highly competitive program. Players meet for 75 minutes each week - a 30 minute training session followed by a 45 minute game. A NFL team-oriented reversible football jersey and flag belt are included in the fee. A mouthguard is mandatory. For Ages 7-10, games are played with modified rules to heighten skill development and assure equal playing time.

KidsPlay-Instructional Soccer League

KidsPlay and Kenmore Soccer Club offer an exciting soccer training program that is second to none in WNY. Designed for both veteran and inexperienced players, the Academy training and League program hosts weekly training/game sessions led by veteran KidsPlay coaches and optional weekly training sessions conducted by college coaches. 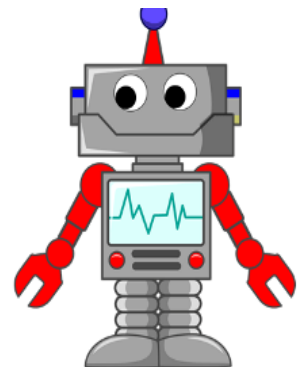
