### Fees Payable Upon Registration

Enrollments must be accompanied by the total fee listed in the course description. Registrations are processed in the order they are received. Assume you are registered unless otherwise notified.

### Course Confirmations

Due to the volume of registrations processed, we cannot call to confirm your registration. Assume you are registered unless otherwise notified. It is recommended you provide an email address when registering online and you will receive an email confirmation.

### Course Cancellations

In the event of insufficient enrollment, classes will be cancelled three (3) school business days before the start date. You will be notified by email or phone. Full refunds will be issued in the event of such cancellation. If original payment was made by cash or check, a refund check will be processed. For payment by credit card, a refund will be issued to your account if original payment was within 120 days. If over, a check will be issued.

### Late Registration

Registering on or after the first scheduled day of class is permitted if space is available, however class fees will not be prorated. If registering late, it must be done through our office during regular business hours.

### Refunds & Transfers

Requests for refunds or transfers must be made to the Community Education office at least three (3) business days before the scheduled start of a course, excluding courses with a specific registration deadline. A medical request for a refund or transfer made after the start of a class will require a doctor's note. A \$5.00 processing fee will be applied in all instances.

### Residency

Registration for classes is open to all, regardless of residency. A resident, entitled to resident fee prices, is defined as one who lives in and pays taxes to the Kenmore-Town of Tonawanda UFSD. Please call our office prior to registering should you have questions regarding residency.

### Gold Card Discount

If you are age 60 and over and reside within the boundaries of the District, you are entitled to Gold Card privileges. Obtaining a Gold Card qualifies the holder for a reduced rate on specified classes. To obtain a Gold Card, please visit our Department office and bring proof of age and residency. You must obtain your Gold Card prior to enrolling in classes to receive the reduced rate.

### Employee Fee

Employees of the District are eligible for an employee discount. For more information or to see if a class qualifies, please contact the Community Education office!

### Emergency Closings

Closings due to inclement weather will be announced on local radio and TV stations. If the Ken-Ton School District is closed during the day, evening programs are also cancelled. In addition, our office is closed. Makeup sessions will be arranged when possible.

### Operation Recognition (Veterans Diploma Information)

According to the New York State Division of Veterans' Services, veterans who left high school without graduating are eligible to earn New York State high school diplomas. Operation Recognition, created by Section 305 of New York's Education Law, recognizes the devotion and sacrifice of all Veterans who left school early by presenting them with a high school diploma. # District News & Updates!

## 2020-21 Budget:

All residents are invited to take part in the 2020-21 Kenmore-Town of Tonawanda UFSD budget development process. Budget work sessions are scheduled for Tuesday February 4, 2020; Tuesday March 3, 2020; and Tuesday March 24, 2020. These public meetings provide residents the opportunity to learn about the budget, receive updates, and ask questions/comment on the proposed budget. The Budget Hearing will take place on Tuesday May 12, 2020 and the Budget Vote and Board of Education Election will be held from 7 a.m. to 9 p.m. Tuesday, May 19, 2020 at Hoover Middle School (use the Sheridan Drive entrance). Comprehensive information on the proposed 2020-21 budget will be posted to the district website as it becomes available, and information about the budget will be mailed to all district households in early May 2020.

## 2020-21 Middle School Music Registration

All parents and guardians of students in Grades 4-6 are asked to complete a short form in order to register your child(ren) for music next year. For your convenience, this form can be completed online and will only take a minute to complete. You can find this form on our website and at [www.ktufsd.org/MusicRegistration](http://www.ktufsd.org/MusicRegistration). You will also be able to review important information about band, orchestra and chorus placement and instrument rental. Please be sure to register your child and to review this information as soon as possible. If you have any questions, please contact your child's music teacher.

## Capital Project:

On Wednesday, February 5, 2020, voters in the Kenmore-Town of Tonawanda Union Free School District approved the district's proposed Capital Project by a vote of 1,082 to 328. The \$75 million project will be funded primarily through New York State Education Department Building Aid with additional funding from the district's capital reserve and a property tax impact of only \$16.80 per \$100,000 of full market value. The project will meet the needs of the district's aging school buildings which are between 60 and 90 years old.

The project will include health, safety and security enhancements including more secured single points of entry in all school buildings, replacement of drinking water pipes in all school buildings to maximize water quality, new carbon monoxide detection systems, new safer "Baker"-style pool drains in middle/high school swimming pools, and new student pick-up/drop-off zones to address traffic and safety concerns during arrival/dismissal at Edison Elementary, Hoover Elementary/Middle School, Kenmore East High School, and Kenmore West High School.

The project will also include new artificial turf athletic fields at Kenmore East; gym upgrades and renovations at Holmes Elementary, Franklin Middle, Hoover Middle, and Kenmore West; a new adaptive playground, which would be inclusive to students of all abilities; additional single-occupant restrooms in middle and high schools; classroom additions at Edison, Lindbergh, and Hoover Elementary; and critical build needs such as roof replacement, window replacement, and resurfacing of parking lots and sidewalks.

In the months leading up to the vote, the Ken-Ton School District held public forums in each school building as well as district-wide community forums and faculty/staff forums in order to provide all members of the community with ample opportunities to learn about the project, ask questions, share concerns, and provide feedback. 
