Late Registration

Enrolling on or after the first scheduled day of class is permitted if space is available however class fees will not be prorated. **If enrolling late it must be done through our office.**

Course Cancellations

In the event of insufficient enrollment, classes will be cancelled three (3) school business days before the published start date. You will be notified by phone or email. Full refunds will be issued in the event of cancellations. If the original payment was made by cash or check, a refund check is issued. Please note that checks are issued twice a month by our business office. If you pay by credit card, a credit will be issued to your account. If a charge is over 60 days old, you will be refunded by check.

Refunds & Transfers

Requests for refunds or transfers must be made to the Ken-Ton Community Education Office in room 218 at Kenmore Middle School **at least 3 business days before the scheduled beginning of a course,** excluding courses with a specific registration deadline. *School holidays and weekends are not considered business days.* Any request made after the start of a course will require a written doctors note. A \$5.00 processing charge will be applied in all instances.

A minimum number of students are needed to run classes. Therefore, **NO REFUNDS or TRANSFERS will be issued after the first session of a class**. We regret that we cannot make exceptions to our refund policy due to unexpected events in personal or business affairs that may require you to cancel. We are sorry that no refunds or credits will be given after the first class because your child is unwilling to attend the program you've selected for him or her.

Eligibility

Enrollment is open to all. A resident is one who lives in and pays taxes to the Kenmore-Town of Tonawanda School District. All others are considered nonresidents and must pay a nonresident fee when indicated.

Seniors - Gold Card

If you are a resident who lives within the boundaries of the Ken-Ton School District, age 60 and over, you are entitled to Gold Card privileges which qualify the holder for a discount on some classes. To obtain a Gold Card, visit our Kenmore Middle office at 155 Delaware Road. Bring proof of age and residency. You must obtain your Gold Card before enrolling in classes to receive the applicable discount.

Employee Fee

Class Descriptions

High School Equivalency (HSE) preparation

HSE classes are designed to prepare individuals for success on the TASC[™] exam (formerly GED), the exam necessary to pass to earn a NYS High School Equivalency Diploma. A certified NYS teacher delivers instruction in all five content areas. Case management and career advisement is available to all students. Residency in the District is not required, however you must be 17 years of age or older to enroll.

English for Speakers of Other Language classes

ESL classes are designed to accommodate every learner's unique needs in regards to his/her proficiency with the English language upon enrollment. Students are placed into a leveled class based upon scores on the BEST Plus 2.0 assessment.

Instruction focuses on speaking, listening, reading, writing, and comprehending the English language. Additionally, lessons are designed to be authentic and highlight vocabulary, conversation, and grammar/structure in real world settings and themes (hospitals, doctor's office, schools, airports, around town, etc.). Enrollment in the classes scheduled below are ongoing and open to anyone over the age of 17, regardless of residency.

Citizenship Exam Preparation

This unique class is designed to assist those wishing to successfully navigate the Citizenship process. To become a United States Citizen, candidates must have a thorough knowledge of the history behind the Country amongst other things. This program is available at no cost to students.

Distance Learning program (GRASP)

GRASP is a free home-study High School Equivalency Test Preparation program for adults who cannot attend our regular classes because of work schedules, family responsibilities, transportation problems or other difficulties. You must be 21 or older.

On a regular schedule, our experienced HSE teacher will send study packets to you at a designated pick-up location. Your assignments will cover the five areas that are on the TASC[™] exam. You will also get instruction on the writing sample test.

You return your study packet to the designated location when you are finished with your assignments. You will set up a delivery system that is convenient for you. There is no set time limit for completing the program that has been designed for you.

The GRASP program does not have regular classroom times, but your instructor is available for tutoring and communication at a mutually convenient time. Tutoring and intake/assessment will take place at Kenmore Middle School.

Pathways to Success/Pre-Collegiate program

Through a partnership with SUNY Erie, the Pathways to Success Program combines the resources of the Kenmore-Town of Tonawanda School District and SUNY Erie to deliver a quality educational experience for students wishing to attain their High School Equivalency (HSE) Diploma and enroll in SUNY Erie.

Personalized attention, small class sizes, and New York State Certified professionals provide a favorable atmosphere conducive to learning. Enrollment is ongoing and case management is available to all students.

TASC[™] Exam preparation

This class is designed to increase confidence and improve comfort when preparing for the TASC[™] exam. Proper academic subtest preparation is pivotal to success, but the key to exam mastery is proper tools in your toolbox when it comes to test taking.

For students that need additional instruction, this prep class may be the extra boost you need to feel more confident and prepared to be successful on the exam.

Overcoming test anxiety, understanding the exam and objective structure, practice with the calculator, time management, test-taking strategies, active listening, and note taking are some of the topics that will be discussed and practiced during class.
