Friendship is truly thoughtful.


My Locker by Samantha Ferreri

There are three dinosaurs that I want to tell you about in this article. The names of the dinosaurs are Tyrannosaurus Rex (T-Rex), Triceratops, and Euoplocephalus. They lived millions of years ago, before cavemen. I found the most of the facts about dinosaurs from the website livescience.com.

T-rex is the first one I would like to explain. It was big, aggressive and strong. It had humongous teeth. It was a carnivore, which means it only ate meat. The name of the of T-Rex in Greek means king lizard, because, in Greek, saurus means lizard and rex means king. (livescience.com/23868-tyrannosaurus-rex-facts.html)

The triceratops had three horns. The triceratops name is a combination of the Greek word tri, which means three, keras, which means horn, and ops, which means face. This dinosaur was in North America about 66 million years ago. They were herbivores, which means they ate only plants. (livescience.com/24011-triceratops-facts.html)

The Euoplocephalus was also a herbivore. This dinosaur's name means "well-armored head." It had bony horns, a clubbed tail, plates and studs. It lived about 73 million years ago. It was the size of a rhinoceros, but it must have weighed more, because of its heavy armour. Even the eyelids had armour. It used its tail to defend itself. It was about eighteen feet long, and about eight feet wide. It was a little bit taller than a person.
