Students - you will be allowed in the building for 15 minutes at a time to clean out your lockers and physical education lockers, with no more than **30** students permitted at any time. Please adhere to your allotted day and time to make the procedure run as smoothly as possible. (**NOTE**: If any families have siblings who are in different grade levels, we will allow them to report together to minimize family trips to the building, and to make the closeout procedures more convenient for you. However, please stick to the alphabetical assignment).

- Students must enter **Door #1** (by the main office), and exit through **Door #22** (by the cafeteria).
- There will be social distancing guidelines enforced in the line in the parking lot, as well as in the building. (If you have been to Home Depot recently, it will look kind of like their system).

### - Social Distancing Guidelines:

- All students will be required to sign in and out of the building.
- Please wear a mask or a face covering at all times.
- Please maintain a proper distance of six feet from any other individuals.
- If possible, please wear gloves to pick up and drop off materials (hand sanitizer will be available throughout the building).
- Students should bring a large book bag or shopping bag to retrieve materials from their personal and physical education lockers.
- To minimize time spent in the building, we will have stations set up outside for your convenience (see below). There will also be staff on hand to assist you.

- No fees will be charged to graduating seniors.

# **Music Department:**

-Return all Chorus, Orchestra & Band Folders containing original music. Photocopies may be kept.

-Musical Instruments: Who needs to return?

- All Grade 12 students need to return their instruments, folders, and music.
- Any students not planning to take instrumental music next year need to return their instruments.
- Any students who have indicated they plan to move need to return their instruments.

### **Directions**

- Ensure your name is on the instrument. A piece of masking tape will work, a tag on the handle, etc.

## **Art Department**

- Seniors must return equipment & pick up completed artwork
- Underclassmen will return equipment in September & also collect stored artwork in September.
- If you have any cameras or other equipment you need to return, this can be done at the porch.
