Goals for Learning During Extended Closure

- Courses will review content in most important units in your course of study during the extended closure period.
- Students should maintain academic habits and thinking skills.
- During the extended closure period, teachers will work to sustain the student-parent-teacher relationship to the greatest extent possible.

Expectations for Learning During Extended Closure

- Time Expectations: 20-25 minutes per day, per course (No more than 2.5 hours per week, per course)
- Students are encouraged to complete as much as possible to further their ability to progress toward grade level expectations.
