Dear Big Picture Families,

We are looking forward to welcoming all Big Picture students for in-person learning in the coming weeks. Big Picture students will begin in-person learning on Monday January 4, 2021. Our records indicate your student is assigned to **remain virtual**. Please note the following important information:

## Instruction

- Your student will continue to log on to their classes virtually from home M, T, TH & F.
- Teachers will be working with your child virtually and with other students in the classroom at the same time.
- Wednesdays will continue to be remote learning from home. Students will complete assignments in Google Classroom.
- At-home guidance and support are critical to your child's success. Please monitor daily that your child is logged into each of their classes and remains logged in for the required class period. It is also important to monitor that classwork and homework is turned in online.

## **Orientation Week**

• The week of January 4<sup>th</sup> we may have shortened classes in order to allow for teachers to run orientations for the in-person students. All students are still expected to log in for class.

## **Return to Hybrid**

- If your family has decided to return to in person hybrid learning you must notify your child's school by December 21<sup>st</sup>.
- No exceptions will be made past December 21<sup>st</sup>, as we are required to be fully prepared to comply with NYSED safety protocols.
- Once students return to in-person instruction they will remain hybrid unless there is a medical or COVID related need to change. Families will need to provide a letter to the school principal with rationale/request.
