Dear Parents, Guardians, and Students,

VIRTUAL LEARNING STUDENTS ONLY

Our school community looks forward to welcoming grade 8-12 hybrid students back to our school starting the week of January 4th. If your child is currently in our virtual learning model and not assigned to a cohort for hybrid learning, please note the following important information:

Instruction

- Your student will continue to log on to their classes virtually from home Monday, Tuesday, Thursday & Friday.
- Teachers will be working with your child virtually and with other students in the classroom at the same time.
- Wednesdays will continue to be remote learning from home. Students will complete assignments in Google Classroom.
- At-home guidance and support is critical to your child's success. Please monitor daily that your child is logged into each of their classes and remains logged in for the required class period. It is also important to monitor that classwork and homework is turned in online.

Orientation Week (January 4th - 8th)

- Some classes may be shortened in order to allow for teachers to run orientations for the in-person students. All students are still expected to log in for all classes as scheduled.

Return to Hybrid

- If your family has decided to return to in-person hybrid learning you must notify your child's school by **December 21st**.
- No exceptions will be made past December 21st, as we are required to balance sections to comply with NYSED safety protocols.
- Once students return to hybrid, they will remain hybrid unless there is a medical or COVID related need to change. Families will need to provide a letter to the school principal with rationale/request.
