



Hybrid Phase 1: Self Contained Students Return 10/13/20

Our school community looks forward to welcoming self contained students back to our school on **Tuesday, October 13th** for four days a week for in person instruction (Monday/Tuesday/Thursday/Friday). All K-12 students who are currently provided instructional support in a self contained setting (8:1, 12:1, 15:1) will return on this date. This determination was made in order to best serve our students who benefit from in person instruction for academic and/or behavioral support as outlined in their individualized education plans.

Please read the following for important information to ensure a smooth transition to in person learning for your child.

Instruction:

- Students will be following their current schedules in person (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday).
- Students are expected to attend school as a *full day attendance*.
- In some instances, students may log onto elective courses while in school using their chromebook.
- Wednesdays will be remote learning from home. Students complete assignments in Google classroom.

Orientation

- Our orientation will occur on the first day of school on 10/13. Safety and schedule reviews will occur.

Transportation & Drop Off

- You will receive a letter from transportation with your child's pick up and drop off times and locations.
- Families who plan to drive their students to school should drop them off at door assigned by school

Chromebooks

- Our students' chromebooks are an integral part of their learning. Please ensure they bring them to and from school each day. The devices should be charged overnight so that they are fully charged for the school day. Please bring the power cord and headphones to school with the chromebook.



Student Attestation

- Consistent with our safety procedures, children who are sick or may have been exposed to COVID-19 must stay home.
- Prior to the attendance, parents/students will be asked to attest to the fact that, within the past 14 days, their child has not exhibited symptoms or a fever, tested positive, been in contact with someone who has tested positive, or traveled to an at-risk area.
- Students/Families must complete the district daily 'attestation' which will be sent out daily through Remind 101 and Email to confirm they are symptom free.

Medication

Please schedule an appointment with the school nurse to drop off your child's medication, by calling the school. When dropping off your child's medication, the following items are required:

- Medication needs to be in the original container
- A doctor's order with instructions for giving the medication
- Parent signature on the Medication Form
- If indicated: attestation form for self-carry (e.g. for inhaler)

Safety

- **Masks:** Please ensure your child wears a facemask to school daily. A mask must be worn throughout the day, including on school district transportation.
 - **Mask Breaks** will be provided as needed and between classes/during passing time while social distancing.
- **Social Distancing** will be expected in hallways and common areas. Classrooms are set up to ensure 6 feet of space is provided between desks.
- **Polycarbonate dividers** will be in place in common areas as well as in classrooms where 6 feet of social distancing is not possible.
- **Handwashing and Hand Sanitizer:** Handwashing will be encouraged throughout the day. Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the school for student use as needed.
- **Lunch:** Students will be 6 feet apart in our cafeterias during lunch.
