



In Place Disinfection Control Measures

Ensuring a clean safe classroom environment for our Students and Staff means that:

- All classrooms are being cleaned nightly by our Custodial Staff with a multi-purpose cleaner as well as other cleaning agents dependent on the needs of the surface being cleaned
 - garbage cans are emptied nightly, check and refill dispensers as needed, spot cleaning glass as needed, floors are dry mopped and damp mopped nightly, student desks are wiped down also and high touchpoint cleaning and disinfection of surfaces nightly

How are we as a District properly disinfecting such a vast area on a nightly basis?



- Proper nightly disinfecting of all spaces utilizing the Protexus Sprayer. The electrostatic properties of the Protexus Sprayer combined with a solution of distilled water and the Purtabs chlorine based tablets provides the disinfection required at a 40%-70% reduction of labor time vs. hand wiping surfaces

Immediate disinfection of hands while in the buildings:



- All District buildings, school classrooms and common areas have a labeled 70% alcohol based hand sanitizer dispenser for immediate disinfection of hands

How do we disinfect differently in classrooms that eat in them vs. the classrooms that do not?



- For Secondary Classrooms- Oxivir brand, Peroxide based disinfecting wipes are utilized for disinfecting student desks and high touchpoints throughout the day as needed



- For Elementary Classrooms- Hillyard Sanitizer #25 in spray bottles and microfiber cloths are utilized in sanitizing elementary classroom desks for breakfast and lunch periods

Bathroom cleanliness, a top priority:

- Every two hours, bathrooms are checked and cleaned as needed along with proper disinfection of high touchpoints
- Check list sheets are utilized in every bathroom

Daily building cleaning logs are maintained by the Custodial department as per the directive of the CDC and the ECDOH
