## KENMORE-TOWN OF TONAWANDA UFSD USE OF OXIVER WIPES DISINFECTING BETWEEN PERIODS AT SECONDARY

#### ALL SECONDARY CLASSROOMS HAVE BEEN PROVIDED WITH OXIVIR WIPES

OXIVIR TB WIPES are disinfectant wipes that use hydrogen peroxide as the main ingredient. These . wipes have a one minute kill time and are effective against COVID-19.



#### TEACHERS SHOULD ALLOW TIME FOR DISINFECTING PROCEDURES

Classes may conclude after 35 minutes to allow time for disinfecting. **Suggestions** below:

- Teachers with back to back classes: Release students immediately at the end of 35 minutes to allow time for disinfecting for the next class.
- Teachers who don't have a class immediately prior to incoming class: These teachers may prepare their room during the available period and may assist with monitoring hallways during the 10 minute passing time.
- Teachers who do not have class immediately following the current period: These teachers may hold their students for 5 minutes to help reduce hallway traffic and then disinfect after student dismissal.



#### TEACHERS WILL WIPE DOWN ALL DESKS AND HIGH TOUCH AREAS BETWEEN STUDENTS/PERIODS

Desk tops, fronts and high-touch areas on student chairs should be wiped between students/periods.



Schools should adjust and revise based on need.



#### ONE WIPE SHOULD BE USED FOR TWO DESKS

Given that the wipes dry quickly after application, one wipe should be used for two desks.. These guidelines will also help the district predict and control inventory. When wiping desks, an "S" pattern is recommended.



#### GLOVES MAY BE WORN BY TEACHERS USING THE WIPES

Teachers may be provided with gloves for their use upon request. While there are no immediate risks to skin contact, regular use of the wipes may prove irritating to those with sensitive skin, thus gloves may be requested.



#### CLEANING POLYCARBONATE BETWEEN STUDENTS

Polycarbonate shields should be wiped down between students/periods. One wipe may be used for two polycarbonate shields. When wiping polycarbonate shields, an "S" pattern is recommended.

Work from clean to dirty in an S shape. Allow the surface to air dry



Dispose used wipes into a suitable waste bin
