Cell Phones - Smart Watches - Tablets



Unless connected to a class assignment, the above electronics are not to be displayed or used during school hours (9:05 am-3:30 pm). These devices *may* be in student possession in a non-operational mode provided they are not a distraction from instruction. Staff may confiscate electronic devices that are on and/or used at inappropriate times.

1st Offense: Teacher device confiscation, kept in classroom, returned at the end of the day, the parent is notified by the teacher

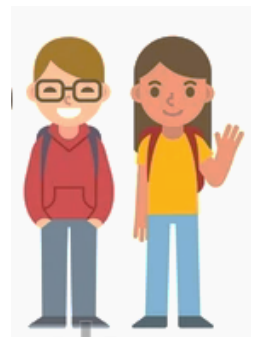
2nd Offense: Teacher device confiscation, device sent to office, returned at the end of the day, the parent is notified by the administrator.

3rd Offense: Teacher device confiscation, device sent to office, parent must come to school to retrieve the device from the administrator.

Appropriate Dress

Students and their parents are in charge of taking good care in clothing choices and appearance. The administrator can tell a parent or child when clothing is not appropriate for school. Rules for student appearance include: :

1. Clothing must be safe, appropriate and not disturb or interfere with learning.
2. Shoes must be worn at all times. Footwear that is unsafe is not allowed. These include flip flops, crocs and other shoes that are open-toed or slip off easily. Sneakers must be worn on the playground and in physical education.
3. Ripped clothing, see-through clothing, or anything that is too tight fitting is not allowed.
4. Clothes must cover the entire stomach and lower back.
5. No inappropriate words or graphics on clothing.
6. No hoods should be worn over the head and nothing should be worn that covers the face unless the clothing is for religious reasons.
7. Shorts and skirts should be of modest length (falling approximately at fingertip length when hands at sides). Spaghetti-strapped tank tops should not be worn - Straps should approach 1 inch in width.
8. No backpacks should be worn in the building after arrival.



Students who do not follow the rules of the Dress Code must replace the inappropriate piece of clothing with an appropriate item. If a student does not have one, their parents will be called to bring in a change of clothes. Alternatively a student may be given a replacement item from the nurse's office.
