Seizure Type	Average Length	Description

BASIC FIRST AID: CARE & COMFORT

- Basic Seizure First Aid-Tonic Clonic Seizure
- Stay Calm
 - Turn student on their side
 - Cushion head
 - Loosen shirt collar/take off glasses
 - Time the seizure
 - Move hazardous objects away
 - Stay with student until fully conscious
 - DO NOT: Restrain, or put anything in their mouth

A seizure is generally considered an emergency when:

- A convulsive seizure (tonic clonic) lasts longer than 5 minutes
- Student has repeated seizures without regaining consciousness
- Student has a first seizure
- Student is injured or has diabetes
- Student has difficulty breathing or breathing is absent
