Professional Development for Substitute Teachers

- Substitute teachers who work a minimum of 30 days annually shall be paid for up to 20 hours of Kenmore Staff Development Center career credit coursework.
 - This entitles you to earn a stipend of up to \$2,000 on a prorated basis. The stipend will be paid no later than June 30th of a school calendar year.
