COVID-19 Remote Online Learning Expectations for Students

Rights

- To attend school, remotely and online
- Participate in learning on an equal basis regardless of race, color, creed, religion, religious practice, sex, sexual orientation, gender/gender identity, national origin, ethnic group, political affiliation, age, marital status, or disability
- Be protected from intimidation, harassment, or discrimination

Responsibilities

- Attend online classes daily and on time and complete all work
- Begin an online class with device camera on to show attendance and when required by teachers during a lesson:
- Teachers will provide specific instructions for when cameras are not required during a lesson
- Some students may be eligible for an exemption or flexibility to this responsibility, however, they will be required to participate using the chat feature or discussion boards in order to verify their continued attendance in the class.
- Express and receive opinions and views in a respectful manner
- Report any incidents of intimidation, harassment or discrimination
- Dress appropriately in accordance with the Student Appearance Code
- Establish an appropriate setting when participating in video-conferencing sessions with a background free from distractions and inappropriate display

Digital Citizenship

- •Devices and networks are property of the school and district and can be monitored and investigated
- •Students are expected to follow rules and expectations while using devices and on networks, just as if you were in the classroom
- •Do not use any form of information technology, including your own personal electronic devices, to intimidate, harass or threaten others
- •Only use your ID and password and not share it with others
- •Only use devices and networks for which you have permission to use
- •Only log on to classes which you are enrolled in and have been provided access to and do not share meeting links to your enrolled classes with others
- •Do not copy, download, install, or distribute software in violation of copyright laws or licensing agreements
- •Do not bypass any security system or feature in place to protect, monitor, or restrict access to information
- •Do not change, remove, or damage devices, networks, or equipment
- •Report any loss, theft, damage, or unauthorized use of a device or network
