Randolph Coach Honored for Win

Randolph coach Brent Brown was named the Coach of the Week by the Buffalo Bills and the National Guard after his Cardinals beat Red Jacket 19-12 to advance to the NYS semifinals.

One week later, Randolph beat Tioga 20-8 to advance to the NYS championship game for the third straight season.

It was also the third straight year that Randolph beat Tioga in the semifinals.

"We knew we had to play good defense and we knew we would have a hard time scoring against both those teams," Randolph coach Brent Brown said.

Randolph's lead at 7 points.

Red Jacket tried to mount a drive for the game-tying score but Devyn Nelsen intercepted a pass with :27 left to seal the win. He finished the win over Red Jacket with 144 yards rushing.

"He's a pretty tough kid," Brown said. "He also plays safety on defense for us."

The Cardinals will now try to win their 3rd consecutive NYS Class D championship when they play at the Syracuse Carrier Dome this weekend.

Brown is in his second year as head coach, however, he has been at Randolph since 1990.

In the win over Red Jacket, the Cardinals fell behind 6-0 but led 7-6 at the half. "We were happy to be up by 1," Brown said. "We kicked off and I felt we needed a stop right away."

Instead, Red Jacket scored on a 50-yard run for a TD and a 12-7 lead.

"That really took the wind out of me," Brown said. "It was exactly what I didn't want to have happen. We had not trailed since



"I coached the JV defense under Pat Slater," Brown said. "I came up to the varsity in the fall of 2002."

Brown was Slater's defensive coordinator for a decade. He took over the program when the legendary Slater retired after winning more than 200 games.

"I did the defense straight through until this vear," Brown said.

respond." Brown shouldn't have worried.

The Cardinals started their next possession on their own 13-yard line and it took all of one play to grab the lead back as Devyn Nelsen ran 87 yards for a TD.

"The kids kept playing hard," Brown said. "It was good for them to have to fight through that."

Bryce Morrison tossed a 20-yard TD pass to give the Cardinals a 19-12 lead. Morrison was hurt on the play.

"He just had the wind knocked out of him," Brown said, "but he had to leave the game for a play. He's also the holder on our extra points so we had to go for 2 because we don't have another holder."

The PAT pass was knocked down, leaving

more than 15 years.

"We have a bunch that have been here for a while," Brown said. "The whole staff has been around the block."

Brown played quarterback at Pine Valley.

"I wasn't very good," he said. "I was a tiny little kid. We had a good running back so all I had to do was hand off."

Brown was a star pitcher and outfielder for the baseball team. He played baseball at Jamestown Community College before finishing his career at UB and Brockport.

He also coaches modified baseball at Randolph. "I coached varsity baseball for 9 years but stopped when my wife and I had kids," Brown said.

A Scholar-Athlete Awards Banquet in December to Honor High School and College Students for their accomplishments both on the football field and in the classroom.








In this issue is our annual All-Football Weekly team. Before the season started I asked six area fans who are deeply involved in the Western New York Football scene to help with the selection process.

Each of the six went WAY above-and-beyond the call of duty and submitted four complete all-star teams.

I will not name these people. One of our criteria is that the committee members' identities will remain a secret. I do not want them to start getting pressured to

name certain kids because people know who they are ... and where they live.

Here are a few items to remember when looking over the selections.

1. All-Football Weekly: These teams are made up of players from teams that have participated with the Football Weekly. If your school has chosen not to participate, your players are not eligible. There are two teams in Western New York that chose not to participate with our magazine in 2013. Players from those two schools are not recognized on the All-Football Weekly team.

2. Positions: Each Offensive Team is made up of 1 Quarterback, 3 Running Backs, 2 Wide Receivers, 5

Offensive Lineman, 1 Tight End, 1 kicker and 1 Specialty Player... 14 total.

Each Defensive Team is made up of 4 Defensive Linemen, 4 Linebackers, 4 Defensive Backs, 1 Punter and 1 Specialty Player... 14 total.

3. Team Record: The All Football Weekly Team is loaded with players who helped their teams reach Ralph Wilson Stadium and the Section 6 finals. It makes sense... the best teams obviously have the best players. While a losing record did not disgualify any player from being recognized as one of the best players in Western New York, players certainly got noticed when their teams won more games.

4. Big Games: Big regular season games and playoff games carried more weight than other games. Big players deliver in big games.

5. Behavior Counts: Players who were suspended for behavioral reasons were not eligible for our postseason honors. The best players should carry themselves with some sense of dignity. Players who were discipline problems for their teams or their schools were not recognized at all.

Behavior counts kids... behavior counts more than winning football games.

6. Grades Count: Most of these players are superior students... or at least good students. A few struggle with academics but they try hard. Players who were

academically suspended because of outright laziness were not eligible for the team. If

you can't give half an effort in the classroom, we will not reward you with post-season honors.

7. One Per Customer: Many all-star teams will list players at multiple positions. For the All-Football Weekly team, each player is listed once. If a lineman is named a 1st-team offensive lineman, he is not eligible to be recognized as a 2nd-team linebacker. Jamestown's Stephen Carlson and Sweet Home's Brandon Smiley are the Players of the Year and are also listed at a position.

8. Attitude Counts: Players that were guilty of poor sportsmanship were downgraded. We may not throw them off the team, but our best players do not taunt opposing players or get into screaming matches with opposing fans or get ejected for throwing a punch. The best know they are the best and they act like it.

9. Super Seniors, All-League Teams: Each League in WNY submitted an All-League team as chosen by the coaches.

Also, each coach in Western New York was asked to nominate players for a category that we call Super Seniors.


These are players that have given everything they have to their programs. These kids may not be allstars, but they are all good kids who gave everything they possibly could for the betterment of their teams.

The football season has now come to a close. There are just four WNY teams still playing.

In a strange way, the 2014 season has circled around and will end right back where it started.

The season's opening week was disrupted by a lightning storm that suspended 17 games that had to be completed later that weekend. Another storm, this one a lakeeffect snow storm, disrupted the New York State semifinals and postponed the Msgr. Martin Association championship game (which will be played this coming weekend).

The two best players in Western New York were matched up in Week 1 as Jamestown beat Sweet Home 35-28. The season ends with Jamestown's Stephen Carlson and Sweet Home's Brandon Smiley being named Players of the Year by the Football Weekly. "I know we would not

be where we are without Stephen Carlson," Jamestown coach Tom Langworthy said, "and I'm pretty sure Sweet Home would not have won the Class A championship without Brandon Smiley. Both kids had outstanding seasons."

Langworthy is preparing his Red Raiders to play for the New York State Class AA Championship this weekend in the Syracuse Carrier Dome. Sweet Home lost a 24-21 heartbreaker to Irondequoit in the Class A Far West Regionals and finished the year 9-2.

Smiley (6-3, 195) is a 3-year starter for Sweet Home and has already been offered (and accepted) a scholarship to play football at the University at Buffalo next fall. He was invited to the Connolly Cup Banquet in December player at the Ralph. He caught 2 TD passes in the Panthers 27-18 win over South Park in the Class A title game. The second TD was a critical 4th-down catch that gave Sweet Home a 20-18 lead late in the game.

"He made a great catch in a pressure situation," Faller said. "That's what you need from your best players. They play the best in the biggest games."

Carlson responded with an even better game in the Far West Regional win over Victor.

In the third quarter of a 3-0 game, Carlson caused a fumble, recovered a fumble and on the next play made a diving TD catch to give Jamestown a 10-0 lead. He made two more diving receptions later in the game that kept dri-

as one of the ten finalists for the award that is given to WNY's best player each season.

"He's an all-time Panther," Sweet Home coach John Faller said. "We've had a few Connolly Cup finalists in the past but we've never had a winner. He's right there with every player I've ever had."

Carlson, (6-5, 200) naturally, was also invited to the banquet.

"Stephen is the nicest and most humble person you would want to meet," Langworthy said. "In my 4 years I have never heard him asking about statistics or getting the ball. He only cares about competing, having fun and winning. He's perfect for a coach."

Each week, as the results came in, it seemed that each player would one-up the other. As the playoffs started, both players took turns dominating games.

Smiley may have been the most valuable

ves alive and led to TDs.

"He was ridiculous in that game against Victor," Langworthy said. "What a lot of people don't understand is just how good he is defensively. We blitz with him, we cover with him, he's on all special teams."

Smiley, like Carlson was also was a stand out on defense. His greatest game may have come in Week 7,

when the Panthers beat Williamsville South for the A North Division title. He held WNY's leading receiver to 0 catches for 0 yards.

"We challenged him before that game," Faller said. "I said that if he was really a Division I player, this was how you prove it. He just looked at me and said 'I can do it.' He was very matter-offact and then went out and did it. It wasn't a big deal to him."

After the Panthers lost the 2013 title game to Williamsville North, Smiley was determined to get back to The Ralph.

"He was one of the seniors that wanted to get back to that game and win it," Faller said. "Brandon made three trips to the Ralph and won twice."

Smiley is also a solid student, with an academic average in the 90s.

"He has good grades, he's well-respected by his teammates and his opponents," Faller said. "He speaks well and is respectful. Brandon is a great all-around kid."

Smiley also says that his decision to play for UB next fall is set.

"I'm really firm on UB," he said. "I have an official visit coming up in December which I am going to take. But I love the school. UB gets overlooked when people talk about great academic schools but they have a great program."

Smiley wants to major in Business Administration.

Carlson has already received scholarship offers to play football at the University at Albany and at Alabama-Birmingham.

"There will be more offers coming," Langworthy said.

"He plays basketball and will compete in track in the spring. He wants to get faster for college football."

Carlson will also have to find an academic match to a football program. He is currently 6th in his class academically and wants to major in Biomedical Engineering. He also has the coaching staffs at Cornell, Princeton and other Ivy League schools trying to land him.

> "Stephen is the most well-rounded player that I have ever coached in my life," Langworthy said. "He is in the National Honor Society, he is co-President of his senior class, he is in multiple school clubs and organizations. He was the Homecoming King. He's an all-state football player. I don't know what else you can ask from a kid."

Carlson says that he has one thing on his mind right now... this weekend's state title game against Newburgh Free at the Carrier Dome.

"This is it," Carlson said. "This is our final goal for the season. If we can finish it off, the seniors will have gone out on top and that's what we've wanted for a long time."

Dunkirk's Mike Sarratori turns around Moribound Program

Dunkirk coach Mike Sarratori has been named the Football Weekly's Coach of the Year.

While it may seem strange to have a Coach of the Year not qualify for the playoffs, what Sarratori accomplished this season is nothing short of miraculous.

Dunkirk finished 6-3 and won the Class B Funke Bowl Tournament. While that's not much of an accomplishment for a lot of programs, for Dunkirk, it's everything.

"We had not had a winning season at Dunkirk since 1994, which is 20 years ago," Sarratori said.

The Marauders not only didn't win for 20 years. In all that time, they achieved a .500 record exactly once.

Overcoming such a long spell of losing seemed insurmountable.

"There was a lot of selfdoubt," Sarratori said, "so we started saying 'Why Not?' Why not expect to win when we get on the field? Why not expect to



together as a team and demanding a great effort from each other."

Once the losing set in, fewer athletes came out for the team. When that happened, a vicious cycle began where coaches were forced to accept whoever came out, just so they could field a team at all.

Sarratori put an end to that cycle as soon as he got the job.

"Nothing was harder than that," he said. "This program had been beaten down for so long. To try and change the loser mind set is very difficult. I think's it's the hardest thing I have done since I started coaching. That was a huge challenge."

Enthusiasm for the program was nonexistent... until Sarratori started talking to kids.

"I did a lot of talking to get the kids to believe that they could be successful on the football field," he said. "When we won our first two games, the excitement was incredible."

make the playoffs? The kids started to believe."

Sarratori said there is no single reason why Dunkirk was a losing program for so long.

"There were a bunch of factors," he said. "Most schools go in cycles with talent, so some of those years the talent was low. Over those years, we started lowering our standards from what we expected from our kids. We did not hold them to a high enough standard from the classroom, to the field and into the community."

The low expectations began to have an effect.

"For years, the kids made excuses about bad behavior or bad habits," Sarratori said, "and people let them use those excuses. This wasn't about bad coaching. This was about kids putting time into the program, sticking The work of eliminating the losers mentality, continued right into the season.

"There were a lot of times when something would go wrong, we would see the heads go down," Sarratori said. "You could just feel the 'Here we go again' from the kids. We would stop practice right there and say, 'Get the heads up.' It took these kids a long time to get the hang of just battling back when something went wrong."

Dunkirk was eliminated from the playoffs when the Marauders lost to arch-rival Fredonia in 4 overtime sessions in Week 7. While it was a bitter defeat, Sarratori says that his players were determined to keep working.

"The kids did not want the season to end that way," Sarratori said. "They wanted that little 2-game season and they wanted that trophy. Those kids were so enthused about the Funke Tournament that we had our two best weeks of practice all year. I was sorry to see it end."

Before the season, no one could see the Marauders improving. They finished winless in 2013.

And, it's not like Sarratori had a multitude of stars to work with. Dunkirk has just one player named to the All-Football Weekly team.

"We had a bunch of seniors that did a nice job and were leaders," he said. "But a lot of them were inexperienced. We basically just worked hard and had fun. Next season, we will have a good group of kids coming back who started and played a lot this year."

Sarratori played high school football at Tonawanda, graduating in 1981. He was named a first-team lineman in high school.

"I was a small lineman," he said with a laugh. "We did beat NT in my senior year."

Sarratori went on to play inside linebacker at UB.

After college, Sarratori started his coaching career back at Tonawanda High School. He served as the defensive coordinator for Chris DeMarco, who is now the Athletic Director at Sweet Home.

"Then I got a teaching job at Dunkirk," Sarratori said. "I became the head coach at Dunkirk in 1990."

Sarratori was the head coach until 1998 - interestingly, the last season that Dunkirk beat Fredonia.

"There was a lot of politics in the district at that time and I was fired in 1998," he said. "I was hired as the defensive coordinator at Lake Shore for the 2000 season. In 2001, I was named the head coach."

After three seasons, Sarratori was let go.

He has not coached again until this season... a 10-year span that left him nervous about taking the head job at Dunkirk again.


"I was very, very worried," he said. "A lot has changed in football in those 10 years. Things are so open now. A lot of Read Option and Spread. Everyone is throwing the ball all over the place. I was really worried about that because that's not me."

Sarratori, constrained by what he had to work with, used his Belly Option Offense that relies on a lot of running plays right up the middle.

"We have a lot of speed at Dunkirk," he said, "but we had almost no football experience. We just couldn't make things too complicated. We had to keep things as simple as we could. We had some size on the line and a lot of speed in the skill positions so we had to take advantage of what we had."

And while "what they had" wasn't a ton, it was enough to earn a trophy at the end of the season.

Simply put, Sarratori breathed life into a dead program... an accomplishment that has earned him our Coach of the Year award.


