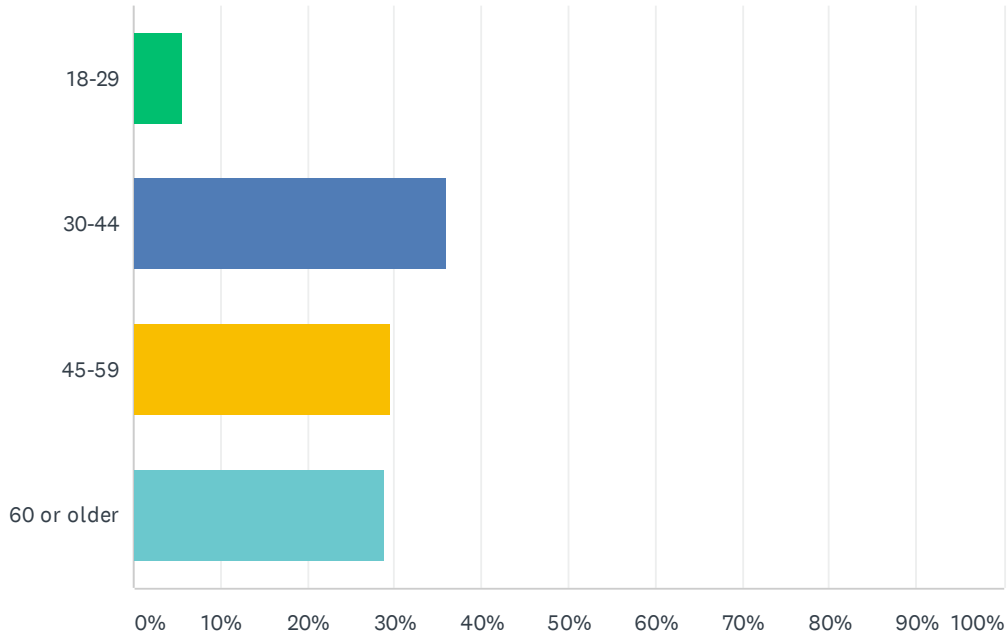

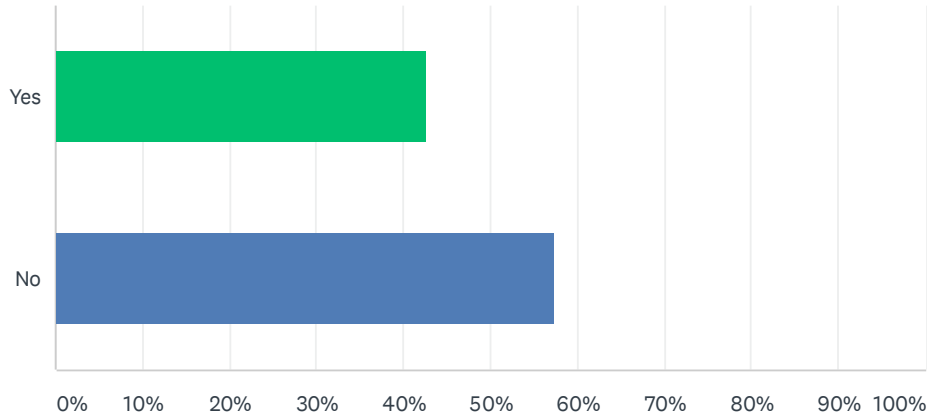

## Q8 Did you attend Ken-Ton Schools growing up?

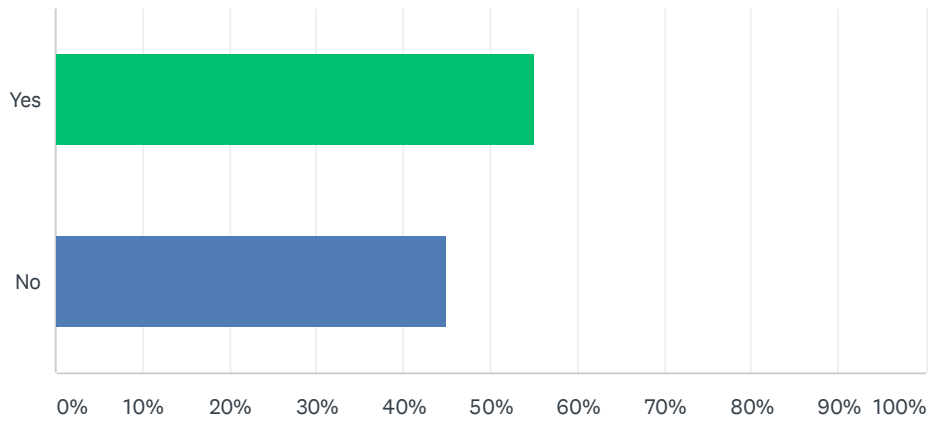

## Q9 Do you have children or grandchildren currently attending Ken-Ton Schools?

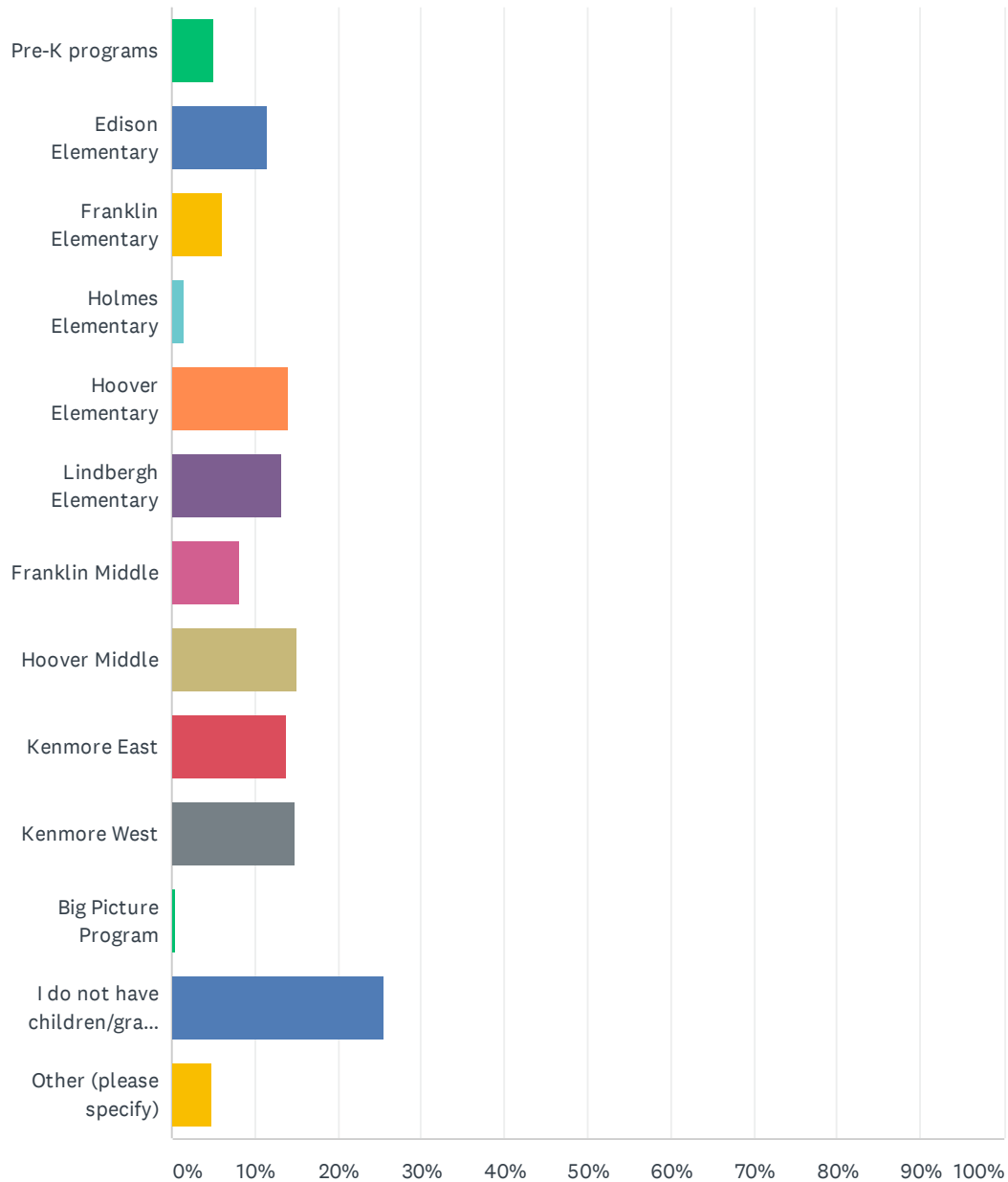

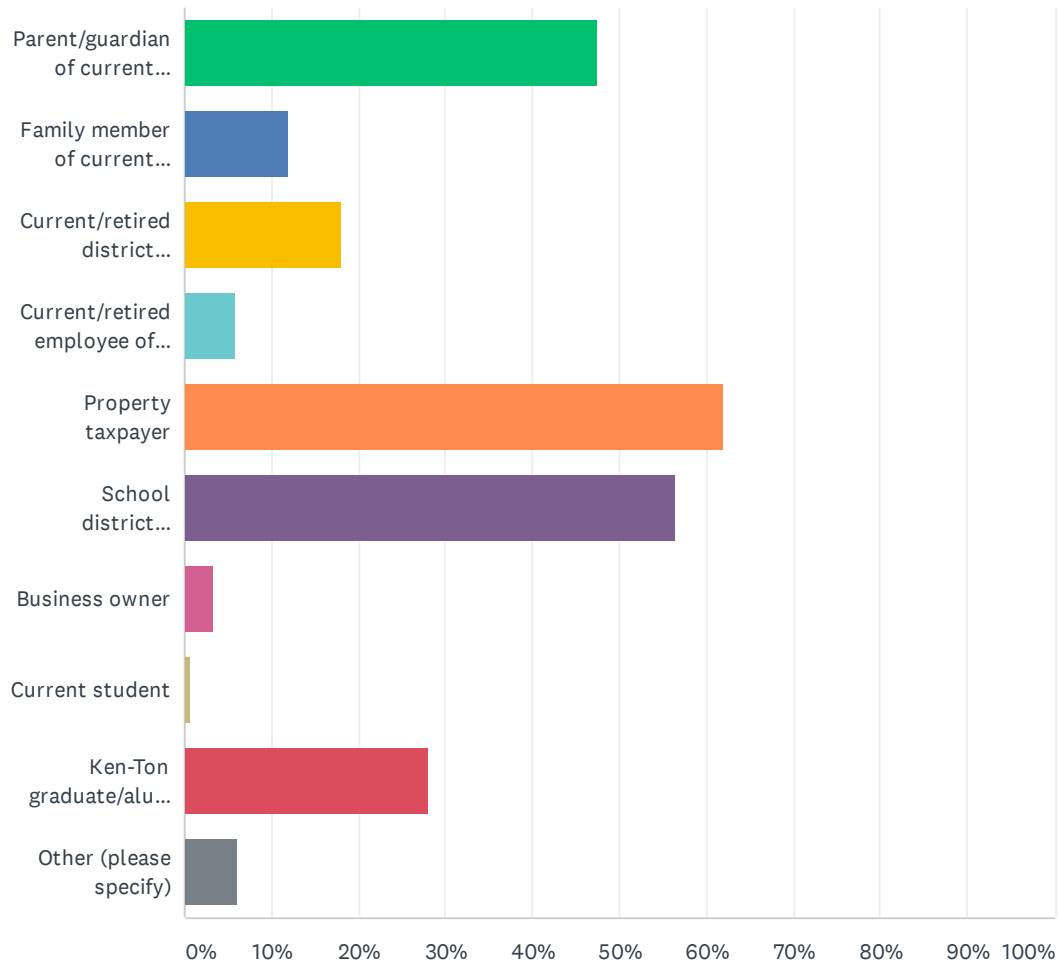
