principal's message



This year the theme "change" weaves the many facets of school life into this annual publication. This theme is not only unusually appropriate but also very basic. History records nothing but continued change. As we survey our immediate surroundings, we observe that it is occurring in most of our relationships. Not only are the physical and the materials worlds changing but also different conceptual and idealist patterns are evolving. This is happening, and it appears to be proceeding at an increasing rate. The only static concept is that change is always with us.

Be fully aware that change creates unknown situations and relationships to which all of us must adapt. Naturally we are apprehensive about the unknown and as to whether we can make a successful adaptation. This unsure feeling is one of the fundamental causes of the dissatisfaction and unrest that all of us experience today. The more change we experience, the more apprehension and confusion we feel, the more we feel a desire for additional change. The increasing speed of this circular spiral has had a disruptive influence on the mores of our society.


Change, nevertheless, is not bad. It is the only way progress has occurred. Without it, we as a people would stagnate. There are, however, conditions under which change toward progress can occur with a minimum of fear and dissatisfaction.


Change is not inherently progress. It must be con-

trolled and guided. Otherwise we may well find that change may turn us backward. I feel change must be directed toward mutually acceptable aims and objectives. Change must benefit all, not only individuals or small groups. Change must be controlled by rules and procedures. Change must not concentrate power. Change should occur because of need. Change must be evaluated and abandoned if the disadvantages outweigh the benefit. The speed of change must be paced so that evaluation can be accurately accomplished.

I am sure that these many changes will open many opportunities for you in the immediate future. It is our sincere hope that your stay in high school has provided you with the wherewithal to accept the changes and adapt yourself to the new. You also must accept the responsibility of involving yourself to the maximum of your ability in steering the course and the direction of these changes.



president's message

The school should not stand to maintain the status quo, but should act as a tool of change. Rather than be a brain factory producing hundreds of memory banks, it should teach students to challenge and reason, not recite and blindly obey. Thinking should be encouraged. So should new ideas in social thinking be allowed to form. The student society in school should be able to grow in its own manner.

For this society to mature, the students must learn the meaning of self-government. It is important for people to learn from their mistakes. What better place to make instructive errors than in school? Self-government, just as composition-writing, must be learned. If the student government is only a puppet organization, then its purpose is defeated. It follows that the students must have a large measure of independence for their self-government to exist. Furthermore, they must be listened to. Any student government is worthless if the proposals it makes are ignored. To be effective, the administration must act upon student ideas.

The school is an institution that has been concerned with academics solely, and frequently not even doing a good job there. To better prepare its members for the world and the future, it must teach about society; the school as an institution must change!
