At the completion of every production, the set goes through a "strike" where all the scenery is dismantled and revamped for the next project.



Now, KE has a new facade and a new image for the 90's. This set is ready for the many scenes yet to come ...




- 1. Scaffolding gives a contemporary "metal-look" to the original

 6. The workers take a break and dance on a window ledge.






Construction "Strikes" KE

Sheila, Janet, Jen, Kory - Your extra time and perserverance helped me through long, long days. You spent hours helping the SPECTRUM in many ways.


Lorene - You experienced the horrors of the color consignment with me. Thanks for your outside opinions on so many ideas.
