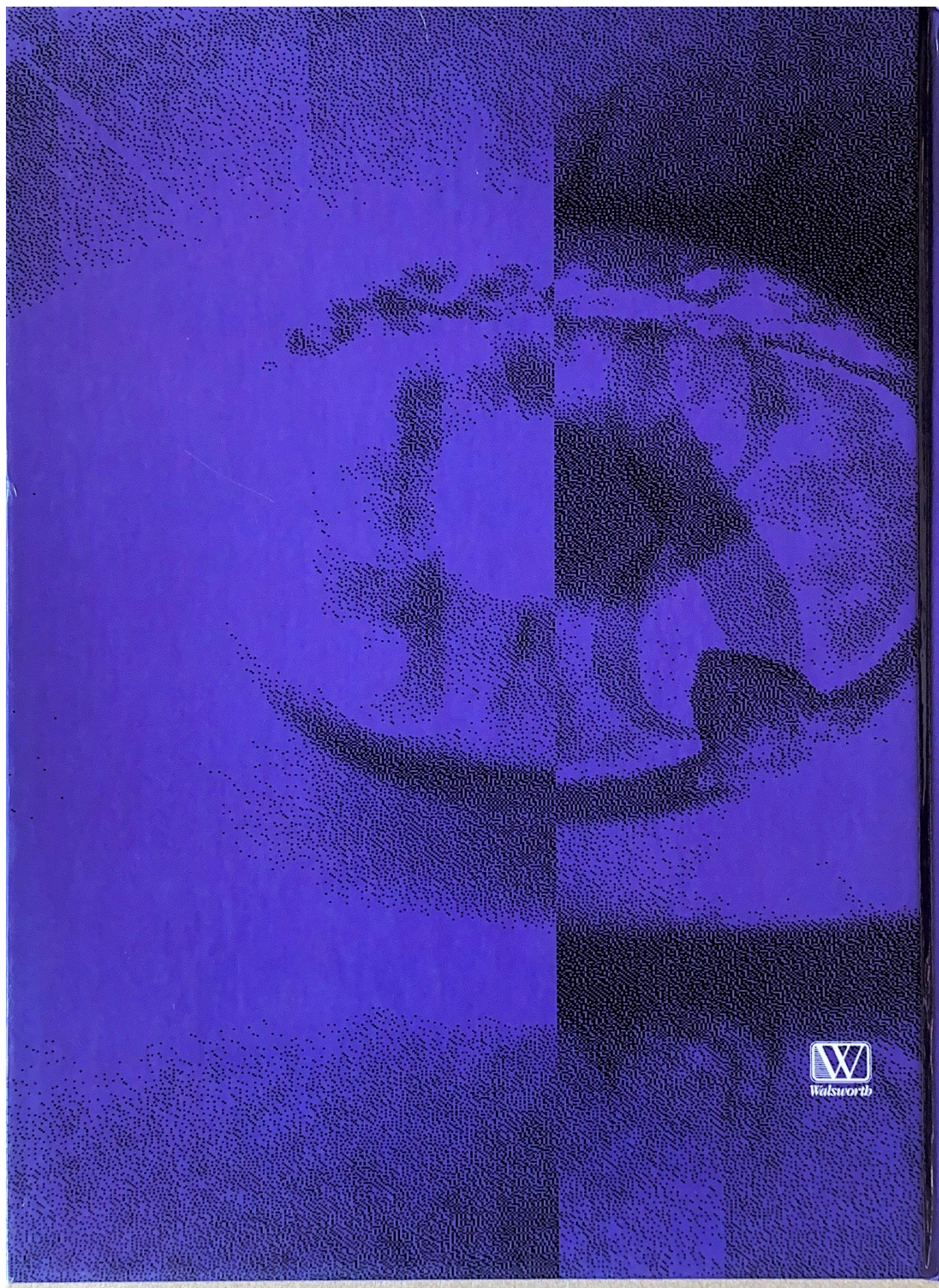

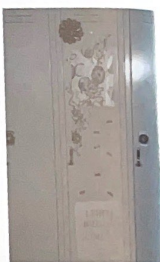
FRIENDS FOREVER

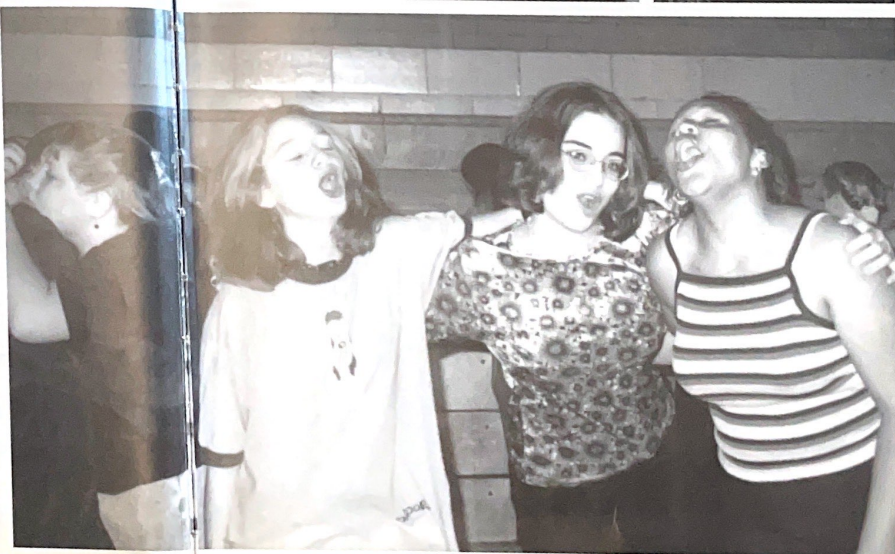

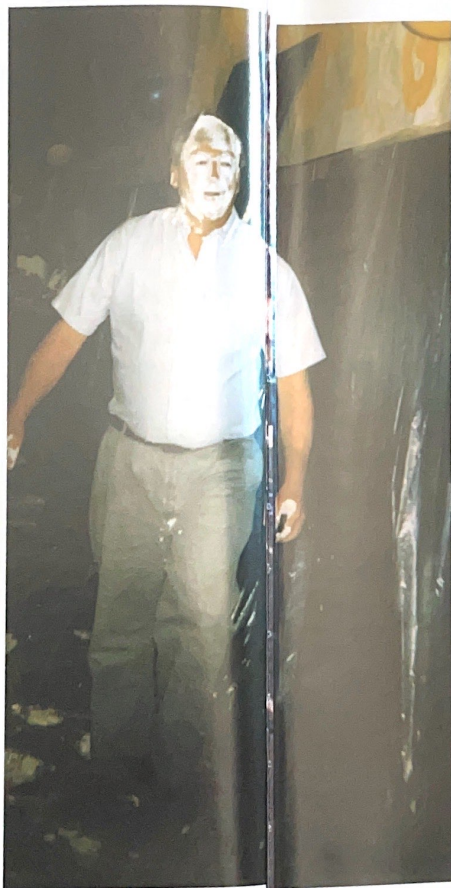


The Big Game

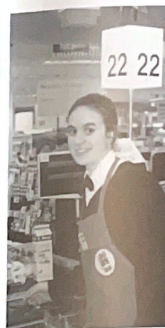

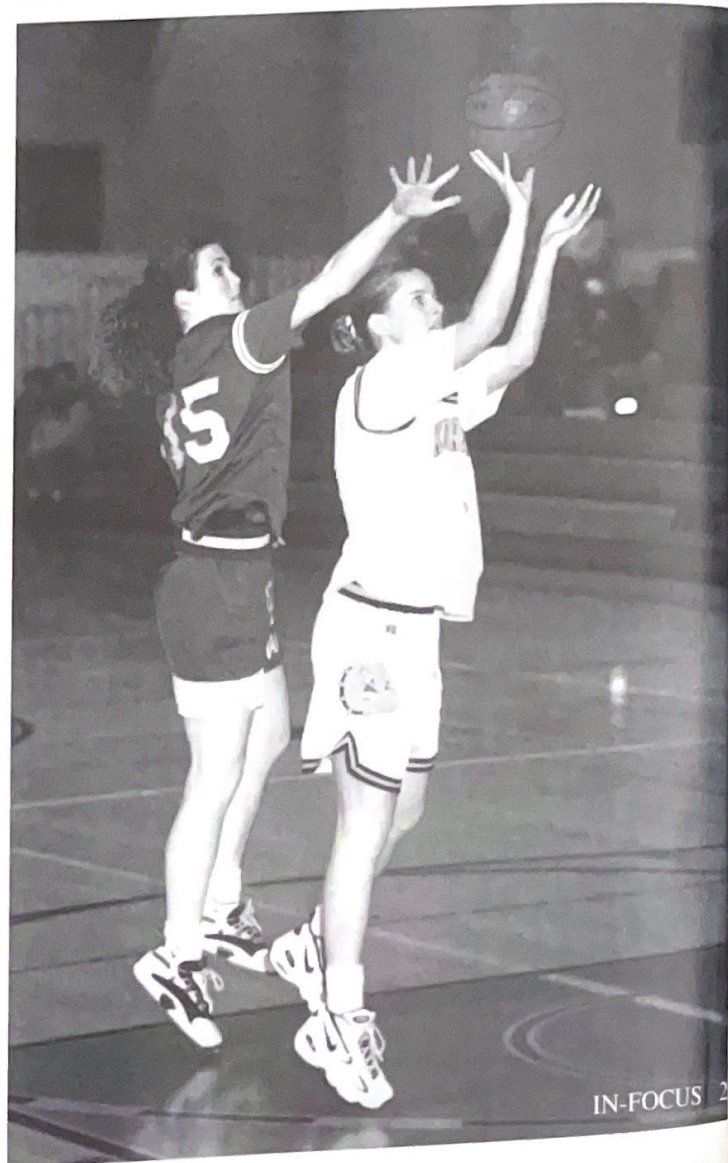
