Spirit Week, the week leading up to Homecoming weekend, was full of great times and memories. Being at KE for two years I have seen the wackiest outfits on various days




throughout the week. Blue and Gold Day has to be one of the days that the most school spirit is shown. The Pep Rally gets everyone together to debate upon which



Being a skater or into the skater style you see people wearing chains that drag on the floor, JNCO jeans where one pant leg can fit three people, and shirts supporting alternative bands.








Learning the Ropes




Daily Life at KE
