







"We try to keep the show balanced so it's not overloaded," Aguglia said. "The judges decided who would make it. We had limited space, so some acts with potential still didn't get in."


Emily Warren, a senior, agreed that the strategy worked. "The order of the acts was diverse, which made the show really interesting and not static."
