**Bradyn Watling**

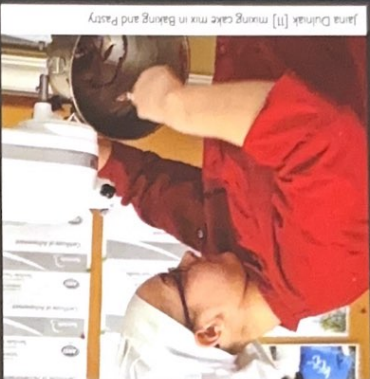

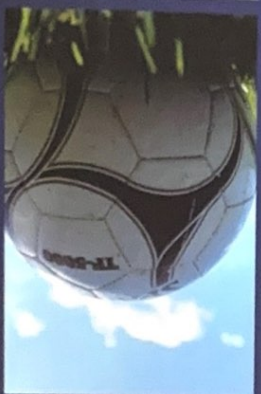

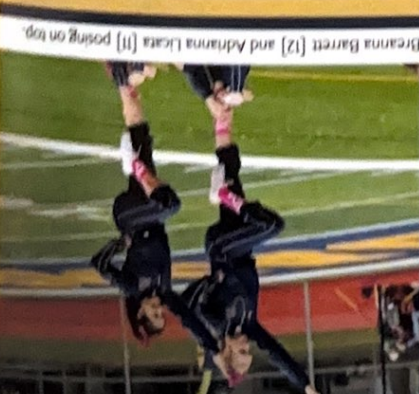

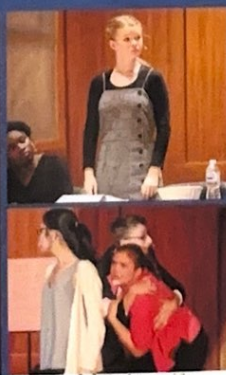
